

### **WAGNER HOUSE** This home is in the style that was tremendously

popular in the late 60s and early 70s – the split level house. The two storey section with the garage is connected to the one storey level at mid-height. 333 Lakeshore Dr. 1970

This bridge on Harden St. was named by Council to honour Miss Rooney. A tireless and lifelong worker for the good of her home town, she was also Citizen of the Year in 1977. There is still no identifying plaque on Madeline's bridge. 1972



#### **1 HAMILTON COURT**

The mansard roof, more typical of the late 19th century, shows prominently in this rear view photo. Here is a less common example of the gables projecting out from the roof. The home faces toward Lake Ontario. 1970s
