- * exhibits for schools.

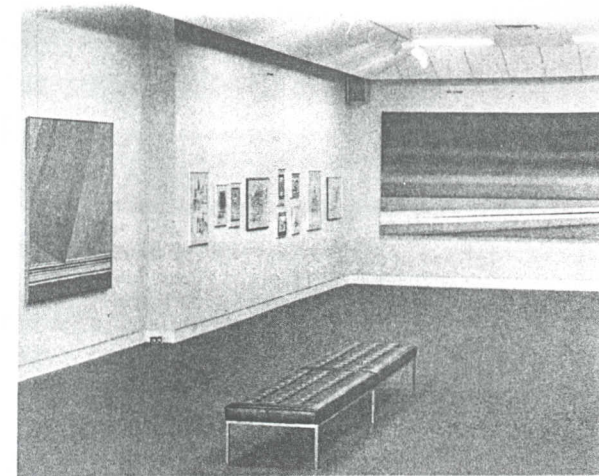
The Art Gallery is
