

# It's now Col. Calnan

Promotion to the rank of colonel and selection to attend public service French language training has been announced for veteran artillery officer, Lieutenant-Colonel Michael D. Calnan, formerly of Cobourg.

Since July, 1973, he has been serving at National Defence Headquarters here with the directorate of land operations.

Col. Calnan began his military career in 1950, first serving with the Canadian Officers

Training Corps and the Canadian Army Reserve, until 1953, when he transferred to the Regular Force.

A graduate of the Canadian Army Staff College, Col. Calnan has served in a wide range of staff and field appointments across Canada, and on three occasions has served tours of operational duty with Canada's NATO forces in Germany.

His European tours have included an attachment to

the British Army of the Rhine, command of the 1st Regiment, Royal Canadian Horse Artillery, and senior operations officer with the 4th Canadian Mechanized Brigade Group.
