

Because of the work of the Ministry of Natural Resources, this river is now the finest source of Rainbow Trout in all of Ontario, It's an Angler's Paradise. Fishing Derby's are now being held both in the spring and fall. Salmon Charters are also available off Mill Street South on Lake Ontario.

The river is also the reason for another unique annual event in early April—The "Float Your Fanny Down the Ganny" crazy craft and canoe river race. This event is held to commemorate the severe flood that swept the downtown area in 1980. The

race is to be held on Saturday, April 1, 1989.

Port Hope's harbour shelters a sizeable number of pleasure boats. Mostly sailing craft, that are owned not only by town residents but by many yachtsmen from the Toronto area. Port Hope is also a Port-Of-Call for many American pleasure bor ters.

HOME DECORATING

WALLPAPERING TIPS

Switch and Outlet Plugs:

Remove plates and turn electricity off. Apply wallcovering over the opening in the usual manner. When dry, cut an 'X' diagonally from corner to corner. Cut away the paper to make the opening smaller than the plate. Add a decorative tough by covering plates with matching wallcovering. Take a piece of wallcovering that matches the area around the switch, cut it larger than the cover plate. Place this piece over the mounted plate and mark corners with a dot. Remove plate, apply wallcovering lining up corner marks. Cut corners and wrap wallcovering around plate. When dry, cut out the opening and remount the plate.

Outside Corners

It's not a good idea to wrap a full sheet around a corner as walls are never completely straight. Instead, measure the distance from the edge of the last strip hung to the outside corner and add 1"/25cm. Cut this width from your next strip. Save the leftover piece. Apply, snipping excess at ceiling and baseboard, and wrap around corner. From the corner on the new wall, measure over the width of the leftover piece and drop a plumb line. Hang this strip, aligning right hand edge with the plumb line, allowing the left edge to overlap at the corner.

Cupboards:

These are a fact of life in kitchens and bathrooms, and not difficult if you follow this basic method. Measure from the last

strip to the cupboard and add 1"/25cm. Cut this width from the matching side of your next strip. Save the leftover piece. Apply against the last strip in the usual way. Trim excess on cupboard side only. Using the leftover piece, measure lengths from the top and the bottom of strip (do not use the middle piece) for above and below cupboards. Match, apply and trim these pieces. Continue to hang matching short pieces over the top and under the cupboards.

COVERAGE

The coverage a paint provides actually refers to two things: how far a paint will spread, while still hiding the coat underneath it. This combination is essential. One without the other means a less efficient, more costly and more time-consuming paint job. A good quality paint spreads easily and provides good hide while still wet, ensuring that the minimum of paint is used to get good hide when dry.

PAINTING TIPS

HIDING

A paint's hiding power is an important quality to look for in a paint. The less its hiding power, the more coats will be needed to effectively cover the original paint. And that means more work and often more money than expected.

ADHESION

Good adhesion is one of the most imporant qualities to look for in a paint. Without proper adhesion to the surface, paint is much more likely to chip, crack or peel. For walls that have to endure accidental bumps, or scrubbing to remove dirt and stains, the adhesion property of a paint can really affect the length of time between paint jobs.

SCRUBABILITY

A paint's scrubability is an important feature to look for, especially on walls that tend to get covered with fingerprints and other kinds of dirts and stains. A paint that doesn't wash well can lose its gloss or some of its colour every time you scrub it, and that can look worse that the stain did.

STAINS AND TREATMENTS

Alcoholic Beverages

Soak immediately in cold water; rub detergent into any remaining stain; launder in hot water using chlorine bleach.

Berries/Fruit

Apply a mixture of 1/4 tbsp. detergent, 2 oz. white vinegar, and 2 oz. water with a damp towel; rinse with cool water, if necessary bleach with hydrogen peroxide.

Soak in lukewarm water for 30 minutes; rub detergent into any remaining stain; for stubborn stains apply a few drops of am-

Chewing Gum

Apply ice to harden gum; scrape off with a dull kife; sponge wrong side with cleaning fluid (or lighter fluid).

Rub detergent into dampened stain; rinse; sponge stain with alcohol (dilute with two parts water); if stain remains, launder with chlorine bleach.

Ink/Ballpoint

Place blotter or white paper towel under stain; sponge with dry cleaning fluid; if some ink remains, scrub with bar soap, rinse and launder.

Wash with detergent and chlorine bleach in hot water; if stain remains, sponge with dydrogen peroxide; rinse and launder.

Paint/Varnish

Use solvent recommended on paint label as thinner, or rub stain with detergent; if stain remains, sponge with turpentine, rinse and launder.
