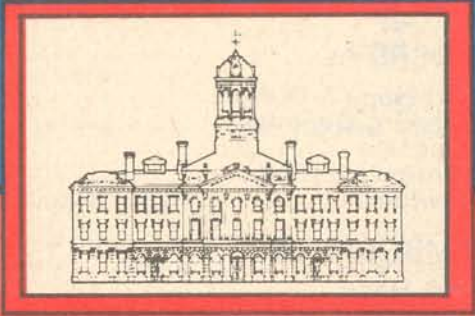

# PORT HOPE

## TOWN OF PORT HOPE

Port Hope is a unique town, combining the rich architectural heritage of an important Great Lakes port of 10 years ago with a thriving business community based on the technology of the 1980's. The Port Hope and District Chamber of Commerce is particularly concerned with promotion of tourism and with maintaining and developing business and industry in the district.

The Chamber of Commerce recently reviewed their Strategic Planning and re-organized to four very active committees: Tourism and Development, Chamber Member Services, Beautification Committee and the Executive Committee. Each Committee places emphasis on specific membership and com-

munity needs and concerns. The Board is run entirely by concerned volunteers. The office is a year-round tourist and travel information center as well as the Ministry of Transportation Drive and Vehicle Licence Office. The Chamber endeavours to promote spirit and goodwill throughout the town and district.

In 1984, the Town of Port Hope celebrated its Sesquicentennial with many wonderful celebrations. Even though Port Hope is over 150 years old, it is still a growing and active town, bursting with vitality. Port Hope grew graciously, each structure has an inherent character all its own. From pillared mansion to traditional cottage, the streets offer unlimited variety. There are a multitude of ways to enjoy our hospitality.

Fishing is a year-round activity in the area of the mouth of the Ganaraska River. This usually tranquil stream is known to burst its banks in periodic spring floods. Extensive rechannelization of the river will prevent damaging floods and has provided many pleasant small river-side parks and sitting areas. Because of the work of the Ministry of Natural Resources, this river is now the finest source of Rainbow Trout in all of Ontario. It's an Angler's Paradise. Fishing Derby's are now being held both in the spring and fall. Salmon Charters are also available off Mill Street South on Lake Ontario.

The river is also the reason for another unique annual event in early April—The "Float Your Fanny Down the Ganny" crazy craft and canoe river race. This event is held to commemorate the severe flood that swept the downtown area in 1980. The race is to be held on Saturday, April 1, 1989.

Port Hope's harbour shelters a sizeable number of pleasure boats. Mostly sailing craft, that are owned not only by town residents but by many yachtsmen from the Toronto area. Port Hope is also a Port-Of-Call for many American pleasure boaters.

July 1 is marked in Port Hope with Canada Day Celebrations highlighted by a giant Calithumpian parade, fireworks and other fun activities. There are also outdoor cafes, crafts and unique booths as well as displays and demonstrations.

The Cobourg plant employs 132 workers, with another 10 at the Head Office in Thornhill, Ontario. As well, the plant manufactures a wide range of other cereals, including Corn Flakes, Crisp Rice, Raisin Bran, Bran Flakes, Oat Hoops, Fruit Circles and Wheat Flakes . . . under 80 different labels.

Canada Colors and Chemicals employs 36 people in its modern 44,000 square foot plant north of the village of Colborne, near the entrance to the Colborne area industrial park.

The plant manager, Peter Astwood, explains that the plant takes colored pigments and thermoplastics resins and prepares color concentrates which plastic fabricators use to color their articles. A computer equipped laboratory offers a color matching service to manufacturers of plastic goods, monitor all products to ensure standards are met and researches new products.

The plant's products find uses in electrical wire and cable, plastic tubing, film and a variety of moulded articles such as bottles, drums, medical devices and furniture.

#### SciCan Scientific Limited

SciCan Scientific Limited is the manufacturing division of Johns Scientific, a major laboratory supplier of Toronto. The local division of the Canadian-owned family business was established in Cobourg with municipal assistance, in 1971. The original plant was half the current size and was expanded in 1977 to provide equal area for manufacturing and warehousing.

The products manufactured include culture tubes, pasteur pipettes and screw cap vials, all of which are used in the health care field and university laboratories. The markets serviced include Canada, coast to coast, as well as many European countries, Australia and New Zealand.

The production machinery is a proprietary nature, much of it developed in Cobourg, and is high speed equipment as opposed to traditional "Glass Blowers" who create laboratory specialties at the Toronto facility.

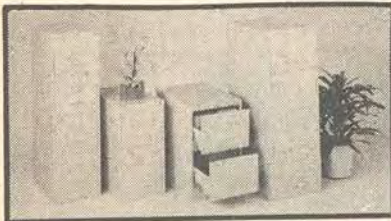

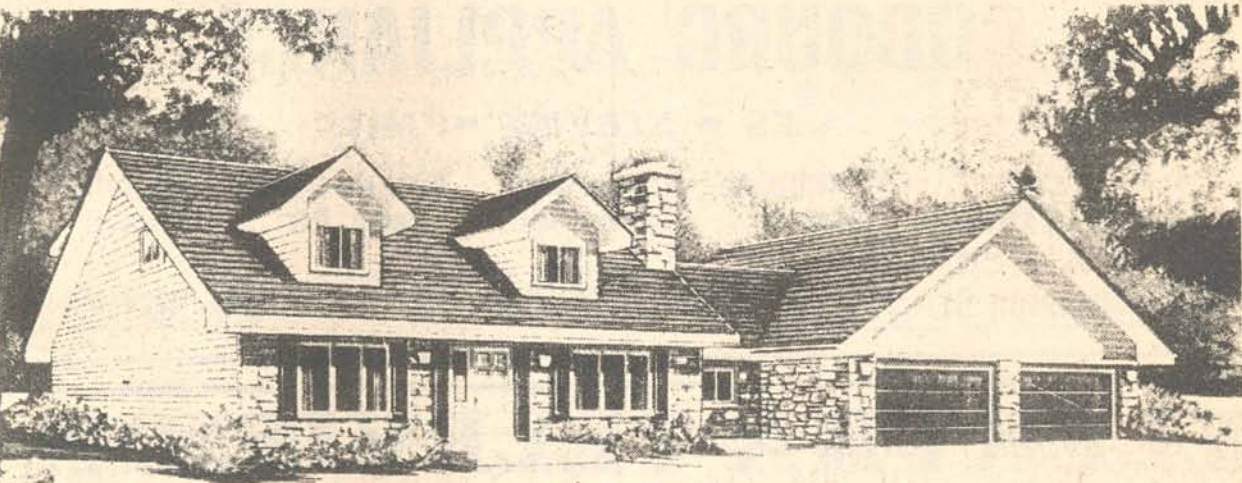

# HOME DECORATING

## WALLPAPERING TIPS

### Switch and Outlet Plugs:

Remove plates and turn electricity off. Apply wallcovering over the opening in the usual manner. When dry, cut an 'X' diagonally from corner to corner. Cut away the paper to make the opening smaller than the plate. Add a decorative touch by covering plates with matching wallcovering. Take a piece of wallcovering that matches the area around the switch, cut it larger than the cover plate. Place this piece over the mounted plate and mark corners with a dot. Remove plate, apply wallcovering lining up corner marks. Cut corners and wrap wallcovering around plate. When dry, cut out the opening and remount the plate.

### Outside Corners

It's not a good idea to wrap a full sheet around a corner as walls are never completely straight. Instead, measure the distance from the edge of the last strip hung to the outside corner and add 1''/25cm. Cut this width from your next strip. Save the leftover piece. Apply, snipping excess at ceiling and baseboard, and wrap around corner. From the corner on the new wall, measure over the width of the leftover piece and drop a plumb line. Hang this strip, aligning right hand edge with the plumb line, allowing the left edge to overlap at the corner.

### Cupboards:

These are a fact of life in kitchens and bathrooms, and not difficult if you follow this basic method. Measure from the last

strip to the cupboard and add 1"/25cm. Cut this width from the matching side of your next strip. Save the leftover piece. Apply against the last strip in the usual way. Trim excess on cupboard side only. Using the leftover piece, measure lengths from the top and the bottom of strip (do not use the middle piece) for above and below cupboards. Match, apply and trim these pieces. Continue to hang matching short pieces over the top and under the cupboards.

## PAINTING TIPS

### HIDING

A paint's hiding power is an important quality to look for in a paint. The less its hiding power, the more coats will be needed to effectively cover the original paint. And that means more work and often more money than expected.

### ADHESION

Good adhesion is one of the most important qualities to look for in a paint. Without proper adhesion to the surface, paint is much more likely to chip, crack or peel. For walls that have to endure accidental bumps, or scrubbing to remove dirt and stains, the adhesion property of a paint can really affect the length of time between paint jobs.

### SCRUBABILITY

A paint's scrubability is an important feature to look for, especially on walls that tend to get covered with fingerprints and other kinds of dirt and stains. A paint that doesn't wash well can lose its gloss or some of its colour every time you scrub it, and that can look worse than the stain did.

## COVERAGE

The coverage a paint provides actually refers to two things: how far a paint will spread, while still hiding the coat underneath it. This combination is essential. One without the other means a less efficient, more costly and more time-consuming paint job. A good quality paint spreads easily and provides good hide while still wet, ensuring that the minimum of paint is used to get good hide when dry.

## STAINS AND TREATMENTS

### Alcoholic Beverages

Soak immediately in cold water; rub detergent into any remaining stain; launder in hot water using chlorine bleach.

### Berries/Fruit

Apply a mixture of 1/4 tsp. detergent, 2 oz. white vinegar, and 2 oz. water with a damp towel; rinse with cool water, if necessary bleach with hydrogen peroxide.

### Blood

Soak in lukewarm water for 30 minutes; rub detergent into any remaining stain; for stubborn stains apply a few drops of ammonia.

### Chewing Gum

Apply ice to harden gum; scrape off with a dull knife; sponge wrong side with cleaning fluid (or lighter fluid).

### Grass

Rub detergent into dampened stain; rinse; sponge stain with alcohol (dilute with two parts water); if stain remains, launder with chlorine bleach.

### Ink/Ballpoint

Place blotter or white paper towel under stain; sponge with dry cleaning fluid; if some ink remains, scrub with bar soap, rinse and launder.
