How public may use armourial bearings

The town council has set policy governing how the armourial bearings of the town may be used, and by whom.

The municipality will have the exclusive use of the full complement. It has been suggested paintings of the Compliment be placed in the council chamber, board room and schools.

The public and community will have use of the Flag Standard.

The Arms, Crest, and Motto, will be exclusively used, in black and white, for staff writing paper and in color for the writing paper of the mayor and councillors.

In the form of cufflinks, it will be used exclusively for presents to past office holders and employees; brooches for females. Cufflinks will be awarded to male employees with 10 years service; a gold ring after 20 years and blazer

crests for the council and staff.

The Arms and Motto, Arms, and Crest will have full public and community use. The Badge will be exclusively for internal use on municipal staff vehicles, equipment uniforms, etc.

The Cobourg Chamber of Commerce have been given the responsibility of managing the distribution of insignia that is made available for public and community use, with permission to collect royalty, including jewellers.

The presentation of keys and civic medallions, with the crest and motto on one side and the badge on the other, used as souvenir items for distribution to visitors.

The Kinsmen club Cobourg will prepare sign bearing the town standard for presentation to council to be erected at the entranceways to Cobourg
