1908 - 1914 Principal of Belleville High School.
1914 - 1938 Public School Inspector, North Hastings
Superannuated in 1938.
Died in 1943.

Received his M. A. degree in 1891.
1893 - 1906 Principal of Cobourg Collegiate Institute
1906 - 1933 Professor of Latin at Queen's University.

Secondary Education in town of Trenton
Received M. A. degree in Science from Queen's University
Taught one year at Wesleyan College, Hamilton
1893 Began teaching at Cobourg Collegiate Institute.
1908 - 1925 Principal of Cobourg Collegiate Institute
Spent his retirement days, California, U. S. A.

 Attended Model School at Port Hope.
 1910 - 1914 Attended Queen's University, specializing in science

 1915 - 1925 Taught at Cobourg Collegiate Institute
 1925 - 1932 Principal of Cobourg Collegiate Institute
 1932 - 1949 Taught at Belleville Collegiate Institute
