Philander Hannah	1851, 52, 53	at 'Head of the Lake'; and Bewdley per 1853 Recognizance.
Barnabas Jaynes (cost of license 10/-)	Feb. 1852	Baltimore Conc. 3 Lot 8 in 1857 Tax Collection Rolls. This was uncle of Barnabas Jaynes of Lot 4 Concl. and 'great' uncle of Lawrence Jaynes now living Centreton Rd. north of Grafton. According to L. Jaynes, 'great' uncle Barnabas joined the temperance movement and moved to the U.S. within a year of owning the hotel in Baltimore.

James Ford	1852, 53	noted as on ' Branch Road ' ('Plain' is crossed through on application - Plainville?). Registered for Lots 26 and 27, Conc. 6 per 1857 Tax Rolls.
Alfred Harris	1851, 52	noted as Gore's Landing. Lot 22, Conc. 5 per 1857 Tax Rolls.
Robert Scott	1852	noted as Cold Springs.
Richard Ainley	1851, 52	Bewdley per attached list and recognizance. Note Martha Ainley licensed for 1853 - his widow?.
Alexander McIntosh	1852	noted as Cold Springs
Alan McIntosh	1851, 52	Cold Springs per Recognizance. Registered for Lots 15 & 16, Conc. 5 per 1857 Tax Rolls.
Robert Hampshire	1851	Cold Springs per recognizance.
Adam Mc Donnell	1852	noted as being on the ' Gravel Road '.
