A Memorial to be registered of an Indenture made the second day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty five Between the Honorable John Hillyard Jameson of the city of Toronto in the County of York and Province of Canada The Honorable Dea Allworth Buchanan and The Honorable James Cockburn both of the Town of York in the County of Northumberland and said Province and Henry Covert of the Town of York Esquire Trustees under the marriage settlement of Stuart C Mackenzie and wife of the first part and George Ley of Saint the Marie in the district of Algona and said Province Esquire of the second part Whereby after reciting as is therein recited it is witnessed that in consideration of the promises therein mentioned and in further consideration of one thousand three hundred and seventy six dollars forty two cents of Lawful Money of Canada then paid by the said party of the second part to the said parties of the first part (the receipt whereof is thereby acknowledged) they the said parties of the first part did grant bargain sell assign transfer convey and set over unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever All and singular that certain parcel or tract of Land and premises situate lying and being in the Township of Hamilton in the County of Northumberland and Province of Canada being composed of Lots numbers seven and eight in the eighth concession of the Township of Hamilton aforesaid commencing at the North West angle of Lot number

seven thence south sixteen degrees east thirty
three chains and sixty links thence south seventy
four degrees west forty chains and eighteen
links more or less to allowance for road on
western limits of lot number eight thence
north sixteen degrees west thirty three
chains and sixty links more or less to concession
road in rear of said lot thence along the
southern limits of said concession road forty
chains and eighteen links more or less to
the place of beginning and containing by
admeasurement one hundred and thirty
five acres save and except five acres previously
conveyed and described in a deed from
Edward and Thomas W. Muchall to W. C. Brown
to have and to hold the said thereby shew
granted premises unto the said party of
the second part his heirs and assigns to
and for his and their sole and only use for
ever subject nevertheless to such equity of
redemption as is now subsisting therein under
