In further pursuance of the Decree
made in this cause on further directions
bearing date the seventh day of February
last and it appearing to me by affidavits
filed that the Defendant George Ley has
redemmed the Plaintiff I have with the presence
of the Solicitor for the Defendant George Ley
computed subsequent interest upon the
Principal sum of five hundred and
fifty dollars found due to him by an
original Report made herein bearing
date the first day of December one
thousand eight hundred and sixty four
from the date hereof up to the time
hereinafter appointed for payment and
I find that such subsequent interest amounts
to the sum of sixty one dollars and

thirty seven cents and I have taxed to him his subsequent costs which have been allowed by the taxing officer at Toronto at the sum of twenty one dollars and seventy cents and I have computed interest upon the sum of one thousand three hundred and seventy six dollars and forty two cents found due to the Plaintiff by my subsequent Report made herein bearing date the twenty eighth day of February last and paid to them by the Defendant Grosbey from the Twenty eighth day of August last being the time in the said subsequent Report appointed for payment thereof up to the term hereinafter appointed for payment and I find that such interest amounts to the sum of thirty five dollars and eight cents which subsequent interest and subsequent costs together with the sum of six hundred and three dollars and thirty two cents by the said Original Report found due to the Defendant Grosbey for Principal interest and Costs (after deducting therefrom the sum of forty eight dollars paid on account thereof) and the said sum so paid to the Plaintiff and interest thereon as aforesaid in all amounting to the sum of two thousand and forty nine dollars and eighty nine cents. I hereby appoint to be paid by the Defendants Edward Page and James G.

Trail into the Bank of Montreal at
its Branch or Agency Office in the Town
of Cobawg to the joint Credit of the Defendant
Grosvenor and the Registrar of this Court during
banking hours on the fifth day of February
next being three calendar months after
the making of the my second subsequent
Report as by the said decree on further
directions is directed.
