She married, in Ottawa, November 3rd, 1870, Hon. Harold Arthur Dillon, eldest son of the 16th Viscount Dillon, who was then an officer in the Rifle Brigade. He succeeded his father in the peerage, 1892. Lady Dillon is the mother of one son, Hon. Harry Lee Stanton Lee-Dillon, F.S.A. Her husband is President of the Society of Antiquaries, and a trustee of the British Museum and of the National Portrait Gallery.
