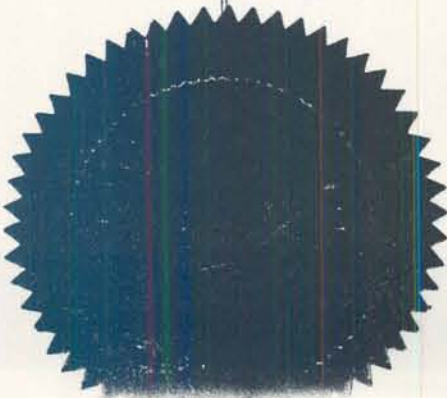
of the said intestate **She** having been first sworn faithfully to administer the same by paying his just

This grant is made upon the condition that no portion of the assets shall be distributed or paid during the war
 to any beneficiary or creditor who is a German, Austro-Hungarian, Turkish or Bulgarian subject or other alien enemy
 wherever resident, or to any one on his behalf, or to or on behalf of any person resident in Germany, Austria-Hungary,
 Turkey or Bulgaria, or other enemy country of whatever nationality, without the express sanction of the Crown acting
 through the Treasury, and if any distribution or payment is made contrary to this condition the grant of Probate or
 Letters of Administration will be forthwith revoked.
