Witnesseth, that in consideration of  
five hundred

Five thousand

dollars

of lawful money of Canada now paid by the said party of the third part  
to the said party of the first part (the receipt whereof is hereby by him  
acknowledged), the said party of the first part doth Grant unto the said  
party of the third part, his heirs and assigns FOR EVER:  
All and Singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises, situate,  
lying and being in the Township of Haldimand in  
the County of Northumberland and Province  
of Ontario - Being Composed of the  
North Half of Lot Number Nineteen  
in the Ninth Concession of the said  
Township of Haldimand Containing  
by admeasrement one hundred acres

more or less.

To have and to hold unto the said party of the third  
part ~~heirs~~ heirs and assigns to and for ~~heirs~~  
and their sole and only use FOR EVER Subject nevertheless, to the reservations,  
limitations, provisoies and conditions expressed in the original Grant thereof from the  
Crown. Subject also to a Mortgage thereon to the Church  
Society of the Diocese of Toronto for about \$1400 or so which  
the said party of the third part recd. is to assume  
and pay off.
