

Overseas Plowmen To Visit Many Ontario Places Of Interest

The end of the plowing match in Cobourg will not be the last of good Ontario soil for the overseas' plowmen.

The group will remain in Ontario until Thursday, October 15, at which date they will entrain for Montreal and embarkation overseas.

Before leaving Canada the Plowmen will have visited a number of Ontario cities including Oshawa, Niagara Falls, Kitchener, Galt, Brantford, Guelph and Toronto.

The group will visit the H.E.P.C. installations at Niagara Falls, the Erin Agricultural Fair, the Spruceleigh Poultry Farm near Kitchener, the joint plowing match of Brant County and Six Nations Plowmen's Association, the Ontario Agricultural College and wind up officially in Toronto at the Canadian Chamber of Commerce dinner and a farewell luncheon by Imperial Oil.
