## SCISSORS AND PASTE.

Wheat and Chaff Gleaned from Our Esteemed Contemporaries.

The board of Supervisors of Platt county passed a resolution that the American flag should be hoisted over the court house every day in the year at 8 o'clock a. m. and lowered at 6 p. m. Failure to do this on the part of the sheriff subjects him to a fine of \$3 and costs for every day the flag is not run up. The county will furnish the flags.

The secretary of state granted a license for incorporation to the Chicago Western Electric Street Railway Company, of Chicago; capital stock, \$5,000,000. The object is to erect and operate electric street railways in the counties of Cook, DuPage, Lake, Kane, and Will. The incorporators are Henry D. Beam, Mater Rosenthal and Harlan W. Cooley.

Among other laws enacted by the last legislature is the one that provides for a fee in issuing charters to stock companies. The fee is on the sliding scale, the bigger the company the bigger the fee. It will undoubtedly put an end to many of the companies with a large amount of capital stock—on paper—and their victims who have been led to invest in some worthless concern will grow beautifully less.

The home of Mr. and Mrs. George Grooms was entered by the grim messenger Death on Sunday last and their little daughter Gertrude taken from them in a sudden and awful manner. The child was amusing herself in a swing on the porch of her home about 10 o'clock in the morning, when a steel spring which supported the swing broke and in the recoil struck the little one a terrible blow on the head, fracturing the skull. Doctors Dean and Detweiler were immediately summoned and everything possible was done, but the little sufferer passed away at 5 o'clock in the afternoon. —LaGrange News.

The culmination of Hinsdale's mysterious suicide was reached Tuesday in the auction sale at which all the property of the dead man was disposed of to pay funeral expenses. The sale was held at the north door of Benton's livery stable at 10 o'clock Tuesday morning. A large crowd assembled among whom were many farmers from the surrounding country. The sale progressed with great rapidity and in an incredibly short time, all of William Schultz, alias Oswald Schneider's effects were sold to the highest bidder. After paying all the bills, it was found that there was a surplus of several dollars, which was sent to his widow. —Beacon.

A peculiar but sad accident happened at the home of Joe Knippen, just south of Lombard, last week Monday. His three year old son came to the barn on that morning and drank a cup or two of milk and in returning to the house passed a swing in the yard which he had often played in. The swing was from a low limb, and the lowest point of the rope was within a few feet of the ground. The boy in some manner got mixed up in the rope, getting it around his neck and when found but a few minutes after leaving the barn he had strangled to death. His little body almost touched the ground and he must have become unconscious at once as a little struggle might have allowed him to regain his feet. It was a sad ending of a bright little life. —Illinoian

A special from Lemont of the 13th says: The first gun was fired here tonight by opponents of the Citizens' League and the newspapers which report the town's doings. A young man connected with the Joliet Daily News brought down a load of copies of today's papers containing a roast of Mayor McCarthy and an account of his treatment of the reporters in the telephone office Thursday night. The young man, who refuses to give his name, was entering every business house, selling his papers rapidly, and entered the triple store of Jos. Felichowski, brother of the chief of police and tax collector for this township. A gang of toughs were sitting around a table and the instant the boy appeared in the door one of the men rushed forward and struck him a dozen terrific blows in the face. The boy was terribly cut and bruised by the blows. He escaped from the corner and ran to the door, the assailant running out the back door and disappearing among the outhouses. Not a man rose to help the boy. The town is wildly excited and the league has started men on the hunt of the assailant. It is reported the mayor has ordered the arrest of every reporter and the confiscation of manuscript.
