She left her husband because he could not give her the further education he promised her. She graduated from the Elgin Academy in June.

A frightful accident occurred on the drainage canal near Willow Springs, last week, by which three workmen were instantly killed and one seriously injured. The men were engaged in tamping dynamite in a hole, preparatory to blasting, and were employed as laborers on section 2, by the contracting firm of McArthur Bros. The section is just south of Willow Springs. Nearly 100 men were working a short distance from where the explosion took place, and it is a wonder that more deaths did not result. The men were standing around the hole almost directly over the dynamite which was being driven down. Suddenly, without the slightest warning, the rock beneath them shot up and there was a deafening explosion. Three men were hurled high in the air and fell over 20 feet from the scene of the explosion, bleeding and mangled beyond recognition, and another was struck by a piece of rock weighing 15 pounds, knocking him down, and inflicting a deep scalp wound.
