SCISSORS AND PASTE.
Wheat and Chaff, Gleaned from Our Esteemed Contemporaries.
Farmers in the southern part of Kendall county are having much trouble on account of foxes killing their chickens, turkeys, geese and lambs, and have concluded to try to exterminate them by having a grand, old fashioned fox hunt on August 31st and invite all the sportsmen in the country to participate. The number expected to be present is placed by some authorities as high as 5,000. A number of bloodhounds have been sent for and great sport is expected.

The Methodist ministers of Illinois and other states are considering the question of removing the time limit of appointment. According to the present laws of the church a minister can remain in one charge only five years. At the general conference to be held in Cleveland in 1896 a movement will be made to abolish this limit. Illinois delegates to this gathering will be selected at the Rock River conference to be held in Elgin in September, and the advocates and opponents of the plan are working to gain control of the delegation.

A new pest, the prickly lettuce, is gaining a foothold in the state and is particularly abundant in Aurora. The plant is a vigorous one, and has a single stem from one to four feet high. The stem has many leaves, usually six or more inches in length, and one and one-half inches wide, with irregular edges and prickles on the spine or midrib. The color of the leaves is light green, and the flower which appears in July or August is a small one and yellow in color. It is poisonous to cattle and horses and should be destroyed by the farmers wherever found.

Suburban towns within a radius of 50 miles of Chicago are just now making a war on the cheap commutation tickets furnished by the railroads, assigning as their reason that cheap rates take many of their would-be customers to Chicago to do their trading. Without the cheap rates many of the people—and there are thousands of them—who do business in the city and live in the suburban towns, would be obliged to move to Chicago, and where would the suburban merchant be then? The question is certainly a complicated one, but it does not seem to us that the railroads running into Chicago are going to cut off this important source of revenue. It is true that the commutation has been taken up in Rockford, and they may take them up in town 75 or more miles out, but the people within a radius of 50 miles need not be alarmed; they will continue to go to Chicago at the same old rate.—Turner Independent.

James R. Petrie and Joseph Petrie, pearl hunters who live at Nycamore, have been exceedingly fortunate in their finds of valuable pearls during this season. James Petrie has sold over \$400 worth and Joseph Petrie received a check for \$300 for a small vial of pearls and pearl slugs he sent to a Milwaukee jewelry firm. The pearl slugs are flat pearls and are used in settings for cuff buttons and breastpins, and are nearly as valuable as pearls. These pearls were found in pearl clams or mussels in the Kishwaukee river, between Nycamore and the mouth of the river near Rockford. They are found in the soft mud washed from the banks of the river where it has settled upon the river bed. About one clam in ten contains a pearl or slug. Small boys bring in three or four slugs every day and merchants purchase them. William Ulrich sent three pearls to one of the largest Chicago jewelers and received a check for \$13 for them. He found them in about half an hour's search. A Swede boy, named Carl Johnson, found a pearl the size of a pea, white in color and perfectly round. He was offered \$20 for it. In fishing for pearls a pair of long-handled tools, somewhat resembling a garden rake, are used.
