

**HINSDALE.**  
 From Dolans and The Beacon.  
 The ten thousand dollar monument of Dr. D. K. Pearson's, which is to be placed in Oak Forest cemetery, arrived yesterday. It weighs thirty tons and required two cars to transport it.  
 The Thanksgiving dance which was given at Everden Hall on Friday evening of last week, was a brilliant affair. About 20 couples were present, some of whom came from neighboring villages. The music, which was furnished by Tomaso, was excellent. It was 2 o'clock Saturday morning when the followers of Terpsichore betook themselves to their homes.  
 The Western Electric company is making great progress in the construction of the plant and system of the Hinsdale Electric Light company, and it is expected that the village will be lighted by electricity by the 25th of December. Over one-half of the poles are in position and the linemen will begin putting up the wires on Monday. Part of the machinery is already here and the remainder is expected next week. Besides the 15 miles of wire which will light every street in the village, there will be five miles of commercial wire for lighting residences, stores, etc. The commercial circuits will cover Garfield and Chicago avenues, First, Third, Sixth, Washington, Lincoln, Walnut, Maple, Pine, County Line and Hickory streets. More commercial wire will be added as the demand for it increases.
