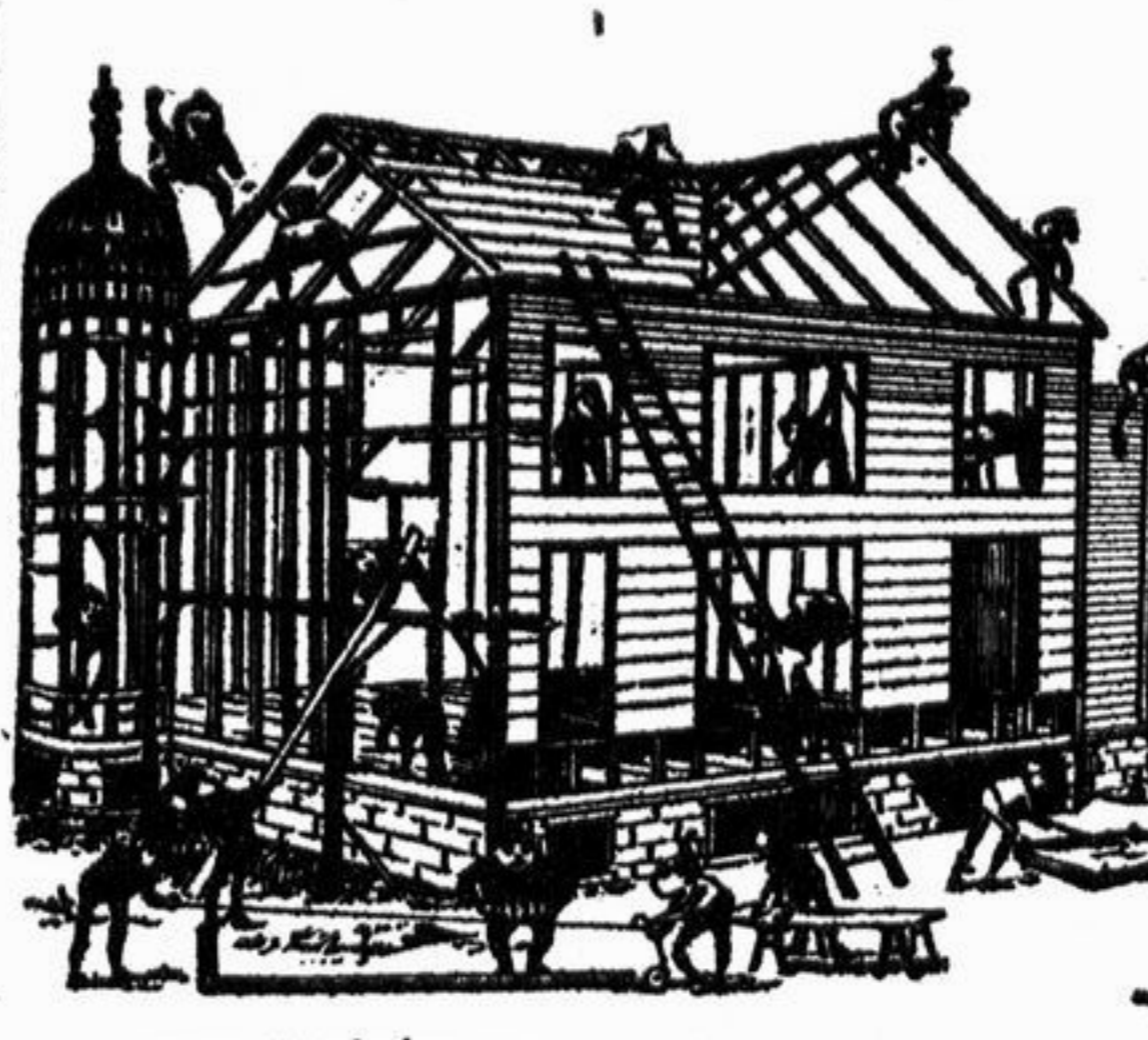

HINSDALE.
 From Doings and Beacon.

A horse which was hitched in front of Bohlander's hardware store Wednesday, became vicious and bit a small sized piece of flesh out of the shoulder of Henry Dralmeier, who was passing. The wound though painful, will not result seriously.

Early Wednesday morning burglars entered an entrance into F. H. Belden's house on Chicago avenue, through a window in the cellar. Their efforts to secure any booty were in vain as a locked door barred their way to the upper portion of the house. They also attempted to enter E. E. Shaw's house in a similar manner.

By removing the rear of the Roth building the business street of Hinsdale has lost one of its oldest landmarks. A portion is located at the rear of the town hall, another portion has been moved to the corner of First and Grant streets, and the remainder will find its final resting place on the corner of Madison and Chicago avenues. The C. B. & Q. right of way takes in the street north of the old Roth building and if some arrangement could be made with the railroad officials whereby the owners of the abutting property could be assured of a permanent opened street in front of their property, public or private, the Roth estate would improve the corner with a substantial brick block containing stores and flats, but at the present time nothing can be accomplished toward that end.

A spirited horse and a noisy switch engine were the cause of a serious accident near Boyer & Kolzow's coal yards early Thursday morning. Mrs. Meyers, who resides on a farm north of here left her horse and buggy standing in front of F. W. Graue's warehouse, while she transacted some business within. Meanwhile the horse became frightened at a switch engine and Mrs. Meyers rushed out to hold it. The horse became unmanageable and overturning the buggy, dashed Mrs. Meyers to the ground. She pluckily clung to the reins, and the horse having freed itself from the vehicle, dragged its driver about fifty feet. A pile of rough stones lay in its path and over this, the nearly unconscious lady was dragged, the sharp edges cutting her face and badly bruising her body. One of her ears was almost completely severed from the head, but no internal injuries were received.
