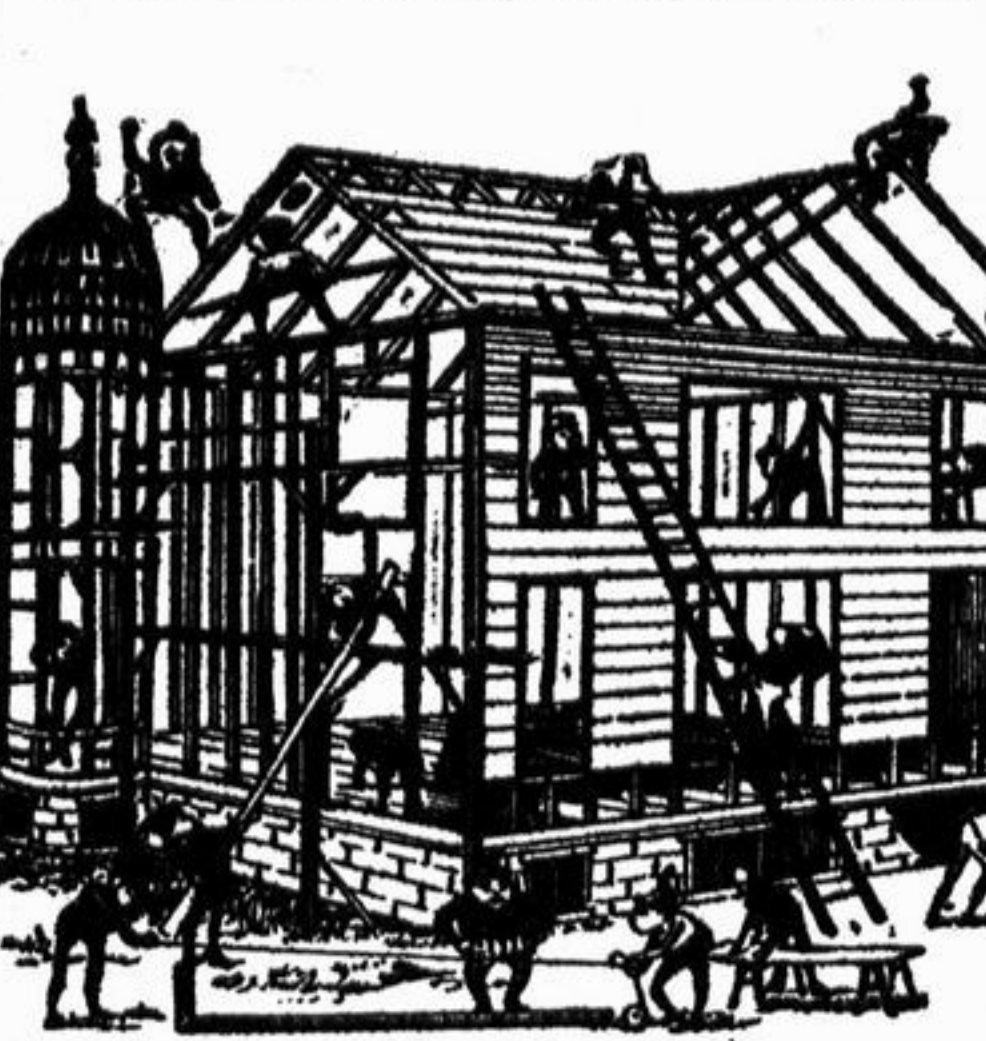

WHEATLAND PLOWING MATCH.
 The annual Wheatland Plowing Match open to the United States, will be held on the farm of John Graber, Saturday, September 19, 1896, where the following premiums will be awarded:
WALKING PLOWS:
 1st premium, \$10; 2nd, \$8; 3rd, \$6. Open to boys under 18; 1st, \$5; 2nd, \$3; 3rd, \$2; 4th, shavings set, \$2. M. Dieter, Naperville. Open to boys under 15; 1st, \$3; 2nd, \$2; 3rd, \$1; 4th, 32-cat. revolver, Scherer & Yost, Naperville.
 Judges—Z. Fry, James Clow and Edward Jarman.
RIDING PLOWS:
 Classes and premiums same as walking plows. Judges—Thomas Stewart, Jr., George Royce and Fred Haag.
FLYING PREMIUM.
 Open to both walking and riding plows. Any plowman having taken one first premium, in any class, is entitled to compete for a silver cup given by the society and donated by Andrew Welch of Aurora. The successful competitor is entitled to hold the cup only on taking the cup premium two years in succession.
 Judges—Wm. H. Patterson, John Brossman and H. B. Grommon.
 Rybars, Wolf & Parker will give a sweepstakes premium of riding plow. Open to all plowmen, both riding and walking. Judges—Healy Alexander, Jay Gordon, Ben Dundore.
 Each competitor with riding plow must use three horses and ride. Each plowman must plow one-half acre within three hours. Boys under 15 compete for prizes. Plowing must be between five and seven inches in depth and not more than 14 inches in width for 16-inch plows and 12 inches for 14-inch plows. Plowing will commence at 9:00 a. m. sharp. The rule in regard to depth and width will be strictly enforced. Committee reserve the right to rectify mistakes as soon as discovered. Agents for the different plow manufacturers are expected to be present and the following tests will be made: Quality of work, ease of handling and durability.
 The young men of adjoining towns are cordially invited to compete for all the different premiums.
SPECIAL PREMIUM.
 The Society, believing that the gang is the coming plow, will give a special premium of \$10 to first and walking plow for second, donated by Andrew Welch of Aurora, to the plow that best works, subject to same rules as govern other plowing. Manufacturers and agents are cordially invited to be present with their plows and compete for this premium. Judges the same as for riding plows.
GRAIN SHOW.
 Open to Will and adjoining counties. Best dent corn, not less than ten ears, 1st premium, \$2; 2d, \$1. Best white oats, 1st, \$2; 2d, \$1. Best red, 1st, \$2; 2d, \$1. Potatoes, 1st, \$2; 2d, \$1. Best 1-year-old rooster, \$1. All exhibits in this class must be of 1896 growth, except rooster. Judges in this class—John O'Connor, Daniel Patterson and George P. Mather.
SUPERINTENDENTS.
 Headquarters, James Patterson; Plowing, Geo. R. Boardman; grain show, H. H. Hyland. No side-shows allowed.
