The annual Wheatland Plowing Match open to the United States, will be held on the farm of John Graber, Saturday, September 19, 1896, where the following premiums will be awarded:

WALKING PLOWS: 1st premium, \$10; 2ud, \$8; 3d, \$6. Open to boys under 18: 1st, \$8; 2d, \$6; 3d, \$4; 4th, shav-ing set, E. M. Dieter, Naperville. Open to boys under 15: 1st, \$8; 2d, \$6; 3d, \$4; 4th, 32-cal. re-volver, Scherer & Yost, Naperville. Judges—Z. Fry, James Clow and Edward Jar-

RIDING PLOWS: Classes and premiums same as walking plows. Judges-Thomas Stewart, Jr., George Royce and Fred Haag. FLYING PREMIUM.

Open to both walking and riding plows. Any plowman having taken one first premium, in any class, is entitled to compete for a silver up given by the society and donated Andrew Welch of Aurora. Each competitor with riding plow must use three horses and ride. Each plowman must plow one-half acre within three hours. Boys under 15 compete for all prizes. Plowing must be between five and seven inches in depth and not more than 14 inches in with for 16-inch plows and 12 inches for 14-inch plows. Plowing will commence at 9:00 a. m. sharp. The rule in regard to depth and width will be strictly enforced. Committee reserve the right to rectify mistakes as soon and iscovered. Agents rectify mistakes as soon as discovered.
