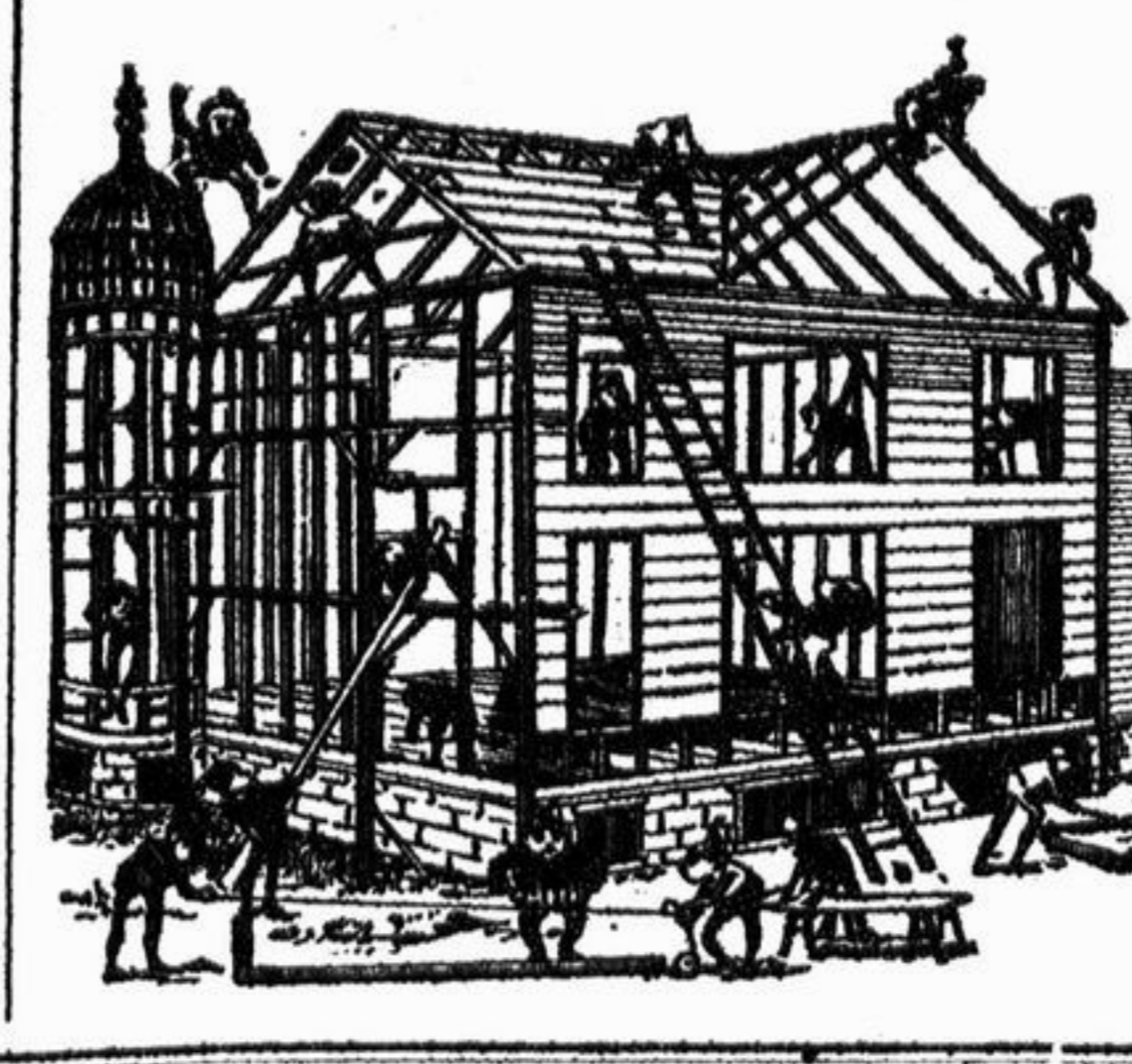

**HINSDALE.**  
 From Doings and Becons.  
 Mrs. G. F. Hawkins of Downers Grove visited in Hinsdale on Wednesday.  
 Officer Nicholson was greatly surprised on Tuesday morning to read in the Chicago Tribune the account of an alleged search for a ghost in the village jail. The imaginative and inventive mind of the local correspondent and fake-author raised this night haunter as the ghost of Oswald Schneider, the robber who committed suicide in the jail in June of 1905. Some time ago the same reporter wrote a similar story about a ghost haunting the neighborhood of Downers Grove and it is astonishing that a Chicago paper would print such nonsense.

The village hall was filled to overflowing Saturday night and a great many late comers were turned away, all desirous of hearing Wm. Armstrong of Chicago, a noted expounder of republican principles and honest money doctrines. He is an orator of pleasing address, convincing way, and held the undivided attention of his large audience for nearly two hours.  
 A hunting excursion last Sunday in the woods north of Hinsdale, terminated in an awful tragedy in which Peter Pearson, aged nineteen, was mortally wounded by his brother. In company with his brother Nelson and Earnest Youngnickler, Pearson came out from the city in quest of such small game as can be bagged around Hinsdale. The only weapon among the three aimless was a rifle of ancient pattern and small caliber. During the hunt the mechanism of the gun broke and the weapon failed to work. The three youths then attempted to remedy the break and as they succeeded, the weapon was discharged, Peter receiving the bullet in his body. He was taken to the Alexian Brothers hospital in the city, where he died Monday morning.
