The tabulated official vote of the various precincts in the county, cast at the late election, which is published entire in this issue of the REPORTER, will be found an interesting document in making comparisons and well worth preserving for future reference. The republican gain in the county over the 1894 election is 2,235. Quite a respectable showing for "little DuPage." The plurality for the republican ticket is 2,559; the majority over all being 3,316. Of this majority Downers Grove township alone furnished 806—over a third of the total republican majority of the county. This is a remarkably good showing for this township considering the vast amount of free silver sentiment the republican committees had to contend with here. More hard work was put in by the silver leaders here than in any other township in the county and the splendid republican victory shown, notwithstanding the work of the silver people, is very gratifying to the republicans and sound money men. Of the total vote of the county, Downers Grove polled nearly one fifth.

That the incongruous elements which supported Bryan cannot be welded together into a homogeneous and compact political force is already evidenced by the free silverites themselves. Senators Jones and Butler and other free silver leaders are reported to have agreed upon a line of policy for the coming four years that will practically eliminate Messrs. Altgeld, Tillman and Debs from the silver combination. The price paid for the support of the Altgeld and Debs following was too great. As for Senator Tillman, he never had any following outside of South Carolina. His contribution to the Bryan strength was inconsequential, for the reason that the popocratic managers early recognized the necessity for keeping him out of northern states and succeeded measurably well in suppressing him, although he managed to flourish his pitchfork near the close of the campaign in Chicago.

Governor Altgeld in acknowledging defeat must needs pour out the vials of his wrath upon the national republican committee officers and prominent republicans including President-elect McKinley himself. The people of Illinois will not grudge him this little satisfaction if he so thinks it. They are too well pleased at having got rid of this element of anarchy and rebellion to mind who appears to them a creature of a diseased mind.

Annual Downers Grove township came to the front with the banner republican majority over all of 806. The total vote of the township was 1,463, of which the republicans cast 1,184 votes. Under the old basis of one delegate for every 80 votes for president, Downers Grove will go into republican conventions hereafter with 23 delegates, instead of 14 as heretofore.

During the past week gold has been pouring into the subtreasury in New York to such a rate that the force of clerks to count them was entirely inadequate to duty, and therefore the coins were put into bags and weighed to accelerate handling in exchanging currency for it. Don't look as if there was a scarcity of this standard circulating medium.

The proximity of Capt. T. S. Rogers was fully evidenced in the enormous number of votes he carried throughout the entire county. In almost every county he was decidedly ahead of his ticket and was elected by the splendid majority of nearly 25,000.
