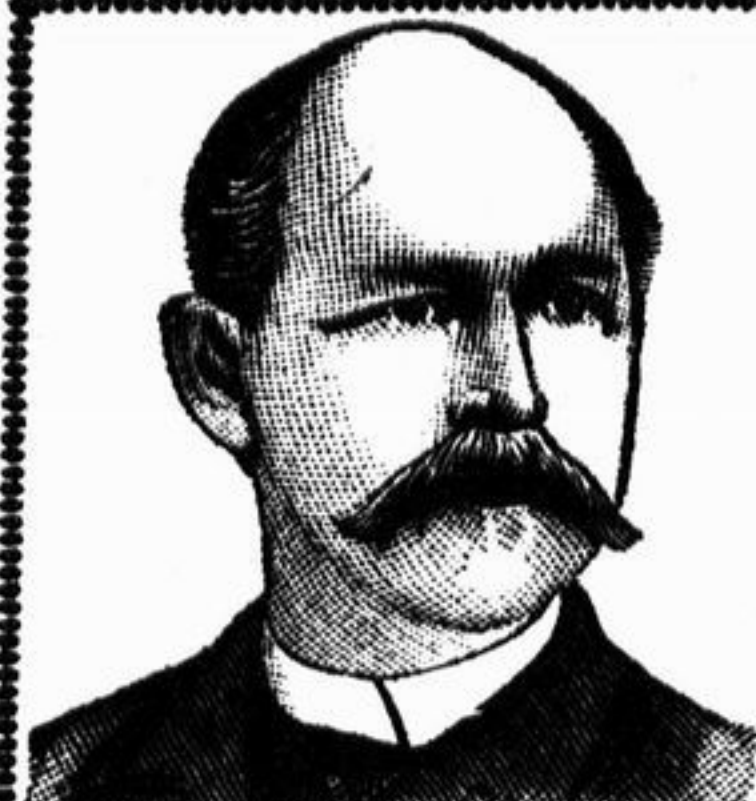

short service by Rev. P. W. Raitabaugh  
at the house, among the relatives and  
a few of her most intimate friends, the  
procession moved to the Methodist

friends from the village, Hinsdale and  
Western Springs, and Chicago.

The services were conducted after  
the manner of the "Friends," of which  
society Mrs. Tylor was a member. Rev.  
P. W. Raitabaugh, the pastor of her  
church at Western Springs, preached  
a well-filled house from the text,  
"In My Father's House are many Man-  
sions," these words being the last  
which Mrs. Tylor uttered in life. Af-  
ter a season of silent prayer the three  
ministers of the village took part, fol-  
lowed by a prayer by Sarah Kelsey,  
who is a minister in the Friends church  
at Western Springs.

The interment took place at the  
West Cemetery. Before the remains  
were lowered to their final resting  
place, Rev. T. R. Green, pastor of the  
M. E. church read their burial service,  
Mrs. Tylor being a member of his con-  
gregation.
