INVENTED THE JINRIKISHA.

Japan's Vehicle for Passengers Designed by an American.

It is not generally known that the inventor of the famous national vehicle of Japan, the jinrikisha, is an American, and resides in Philadelphia, says the Pittsburgh Dispatch.

After finishing a four years' course he was, in 1859, ordained a baptist minister and sent to Japan as a missionary by the American Baptist Free Missionary society.

For many years past Japan has exported many thousands of these vehicles to other eastern countries. In Tokyo alone there are not fewer than 500,000 now in use.
