Items of General Interest Told in Paragraphs.

COMPLETE NEWS SUMMARY.

Record of Happenings of Much or Little Importance from All Parts of the Civilized World—Prices of Farm Produce in Western Markets.

Canton, Ohio.—John D. Frank's wholesale and retail shoe store was burned. Loss, \$50,000.

Washington.—The United States hospital ship Missouri, from Manila for San Francisco, with 236 sick soldiers aboard, arrived at Nagasaki, Japan.

London.—Another effort to float the American line steamer Paris out of dock at Milford Haven failed.

Harrisburg, Pa.—James Calhoun, formerly resident manager of the Equitable Life Insurance company, committed suicide by shooting himself.

Washington.—Max Krebs, a young German, recently arrested, has confessed to being "Jack the Slasher," who cut a number of ladies' dresses and to having committed a number of similar acts in Philadelphia and New York.

Washington.—The comptroller of the currency has declared dividends in favor of the creditors of insolvent national banks as follows: One per cent, Merchants' National bank of Great Falls, Mont.; 6.5 per cent, National bank of Kansas City, Mo.

Winnipeg, Man.—Hugh John Macdonald formally accepted the task of forming a government in succession to the Greenway administration, which recently resigned.

Sioux City, Iowa.—Gov. Shaw, on behalf of the state, offered \$500 for the arrest and conviction of the murderer of John E. Robson.

New York.—John D. Rockefeller has presented \$100,000 to Columbia university for the endowment of a chair of psychology.

Washington.—The contract for the erection of an electric lighting plant at the Norfolk, Va., navy yard was awarded to L. L. Leach & Son of Chicago, at their bid of \$73,371.

Bangor, Maine.—The latest reports from Congressman Boutelle are of an encouraging nature.

Ashtabula, Ohio.—Baron D. Mortey, cashier of the Citizens' bank of Andover, died of paralysis.

Madrid.—The basis of a treaty to replace the treaties of 1795 and 1817 has been drawn up by Premier Silveira and the United States minister, Bellamy Storer, and a copy has been sent to Washington for approval.

Buffalo, N. Y.—James W. Chase, a builder and contractor of this city, was adjudged a bankrupt.

New York.—The committee having in charge the perpetuation of the Dewey arch is assured a fund of \$200,000.

New York.—Charles Beers, surviving partner of the firm of F. Bianchi & Co., wholesale dealers in millinery goods, made an assignment for the benefit of creditors.

Duluth, Minn.—The Pioneer Steel Elevator company has been organized for the construction of a very large grain elevator here, to hold 4,000,000 bushels of grain.

Mattoon, Ill.—The sale of the Peoria, Decatur & Evansville railroad was postponed for thirty days.

Albany, N. Y.—Chiara Cignarale, who murdered her husband in New York city April 20, 1896, and who was serving a life sentence in Auburn prison, was pardoned by Gov. Roosevelt.

Des Moines, Iowa.—Miss Emma Dye, principal of Lucas school, tried to fill a gasoline stove tank while the jet was lighted, and was so badly burned in the explosion that it is thought she cannot live.

Niles, Mich.—William Webb, a farmer, living six miles east of this city, was killed by a Michigan Central train.

Pittsburg, Pa.—Jerome Desco, a jeweler of Washington, came to Pittsburg and identified Charles E. Hoyt, at central police station, as a member of the gang which robbed his store of a tray of diamonds valued at \$3,000 on March 16, 1897.

Moline, Ill.—Mrs. Minnie McWharter, while temporarily insane from domestic troubles, committed suicide.

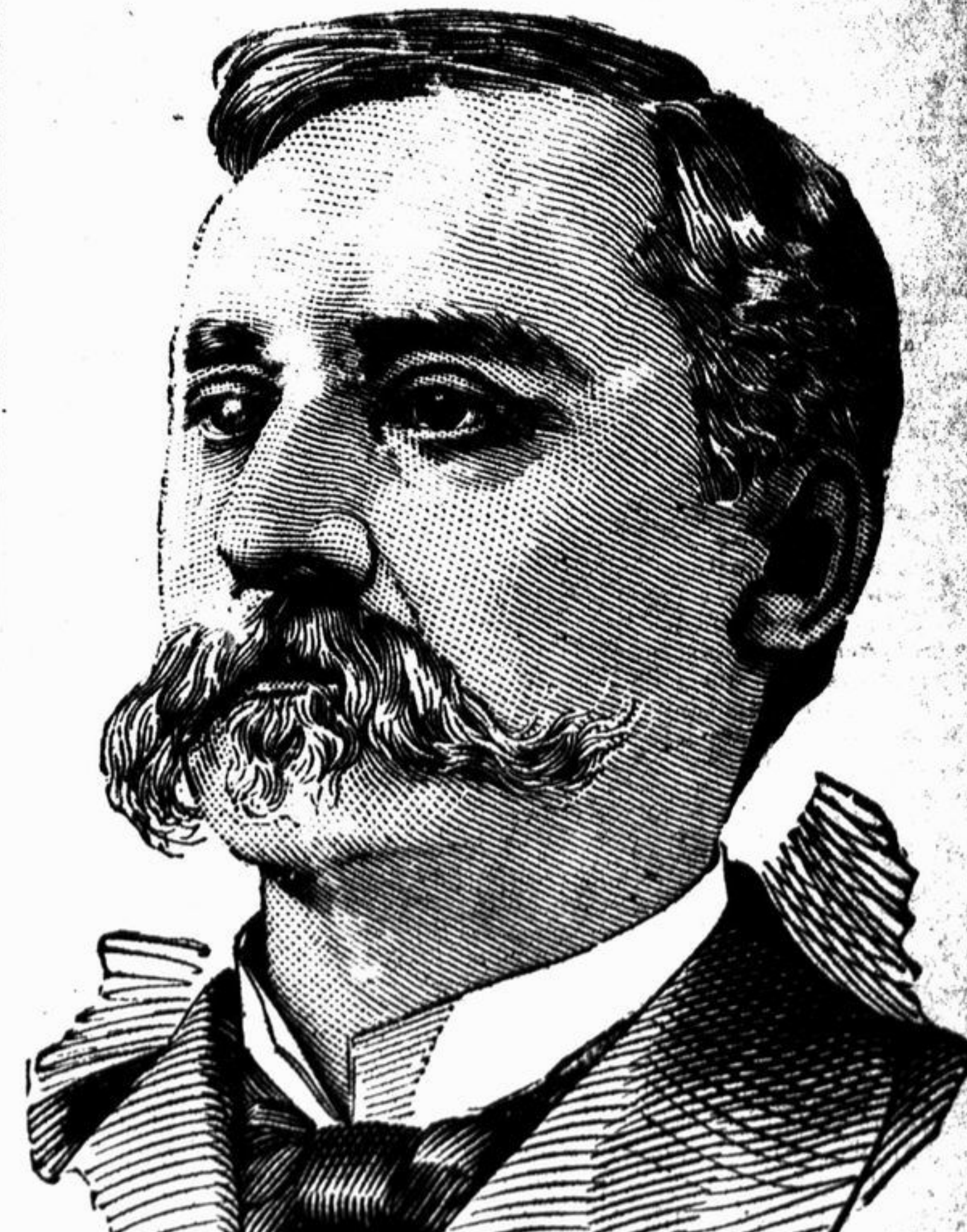
