

Passantic Tubes for Postal Service. The pneumatic tube in the postal service has been forcibly endorsed by the action of Postmaster Van Cott of New York, who has asked for money for its extension. All the mail matter going out of the Grand Central station is handled through one of these tubes, and it is estimated that about 800,000 pleces daily pass through this one conduit. The distance is three and onequarter miles, and the trip is made in seven and one-half minutes. The carriers hold about 300 letters, and they make a total of 2,000 trips per day.
