Just now Downers Grove is in the throes of its frequent 'sloppy weather' campaign with muddy streets and crossings.

There can be but one result at the Philadelphia convention next June. The present incumbent of the White House will be nominated by acclamation.

The republican county central committee has decided not to call the county convention to elect delegates to the state convention until early in May.
