REPUBLICAN PLATFORM.

The republican platform adopted at Philadelphia is a clear and sincere presentation of the work of the administration during the last four years and its purpose is to gain endorsement by the people. It will be approved by all republicans and no one who reads its plain and unequivocal declaration can have any doubt regarding the principles and policies of the party.

The trust plank will probably invite more scrutiny than any other. The platform recognizes the necessity for the honest cooperation of capital to meet new business conditions, and at the same time it condemns "all conspiracies and combinations intended to restrict business, to create monopolies, to limit production or to control prices."

There is a frank and forcible pronouncement on the trust question. The endorsement of the time-honored policy of protection for American labor is coupled with a clause favoring reciprocity with foreign countries, "so directed as to open our markets on favorable terms for what we do not ourselves produce in return for free foreign markets."

When the expansion question is taken up, the anti-imperialists will look in vain through the platform for any traces of imperialism. They will find instead a plain and sober declaration of purpose to restore order and establish good government in the Philippines, a promise to give the inhabitants of those islands "the largest measure of self-government consistent with their welfare and our duties," and a promise to give Cuba independence and self-government.

The platform contains many planks, but all of them are to the point. On the principles laid down at Philadelphia, the republican party can go before the people with courage and confidence.
