The dangers of the grade crossing at the intersection of the Burlington tracks and Maple avenue, is being made the subject of petitions to the officials for some method of lessening the danger, either by maintaining gates, or raising the tracks, and cutting the street through under.

The October grand jury it is said will investigate blind pigs in DuPage county and Hinsdale and Lisle may come in for some attention. Singular as it may seem blind-pigs are unknown animals so far as the circuit court in recent terms is concerned.
