JUDGE YATES TO THE GERMAN.

Hon. Richard Yates, the Republican candidate for governor of Illinois, has this to say to the German-American voters of Illinois: "The Democrats are claiming that they will carry the state this fall by appealing to just one class of our fellow-citizens, the German-Americans."

In his speech at Chicago Saturday, Governor Tanner censured the extravagant and inefficient management of the State institutions under the Allgeld regime, which differed so strikingly from the business-like and economical way in which the affairs of these institutions have been conducted under the present administration.

All that Illinois Republicans will have to do to elect their entire state ticket, give McKinley and Roosevelt a handsome majority and secure a good working majority in the legislature with which to elect a United States senator, is to go to the polls on Nov. 6 and vote. There are plenty of Republicans in Illinois to accomplish this, and there need be no failure in any part of it if all Republicans will perform this important duty.

In 1900, after having fought a successful war, and with its resultant difficulties and problems still before him, President McKinley is made the subject of exactly the same charges as was President Lincoln in 1864 by the Democracy of that day.

Honestly now, does anyone really think for a moment that the attitude of the republican party in the control of the Philippines savors of imperialism? Such a thing cannot exist under a republican form of government.
