upon said parcel of ground, shall be upon the condition that it shall be used for tracks only and such appliances as shall be necessary for the operation of its road, and that the said railway company, and its successors, shall not, after said railway is completed and in operation, have, establish and maintain upon said parcel of ground, or within 200 feet thereof, any freight or passenger depot or other buildings whatsoever, cranes, hoists or sidetracks, except that during the period of construction of said railroad said construct and use sidetracks and switches upon said land, and use steam locomotives for such construction purposes only, and sidetracks and switches to be removed when the construction of the said railroad is completed. And provided further, that if the said The Aurora, Wheaton and Chicago Railway Company, or its successors, shall cease to operate a line of railway, over, along and upon said parcel of ground after said railway shall have been established and completed, or shall violate any of the provisions and conditions of this grant in made, as herein specified, then the said DuPage County shall have the right to declare said grant terminated and to reacquire said strip of land; And provided further, that said railway company shall, upon taking possession of said premises, remove the north fence on the court house grounds to the south line of said hereinbefore described parcel of land, and rebuild the same to the satisfaction of the court house and grounds committee of the board of supervisors of the County of DuPage, and of the same pattern, quality and kind as shall be maintained by said county around the other sides of said court house ground. And thereafter, during the term of this grant, shall keep and maintain said fence in good repair, to the satisfaction of said county board. And provided further, that this grant is made upon the express stipulation by said railway company to and with the said county, that if any action shall be brought by the county to terminate this grant because of the failure of said company to keep and observe any of the conditions and stipulations by it to be kept and performed; or if, on account of any violation of this contract by said railway company, or its successors, said county shall obtain judgment or decree against said railway company, or its successor or successors, it shall also recover in said action, all costs, including all reasonable attorneys or solicitors' fees expended by said county in and about such actions, or in obtaining such judgments and decrees.

And it is expressly agreed by and between the said County of DuPage and the said railway company, that this resolution shall take effect and be binding both upon said county and said railway company, immediately upon said railway company filing with the county clerk of DuPage County, its acceptance thereof, and that from and after the filing of such acceptance shall be a valid and binding contract between said County of DuPage and said railway company; provided such acceptance be filed within thirty days after the passage of this resolution.

On motion of Supervisor Bartlett, the salary of the sheriff's clerk and jailer was raised from \$35 to \$40 per month.
