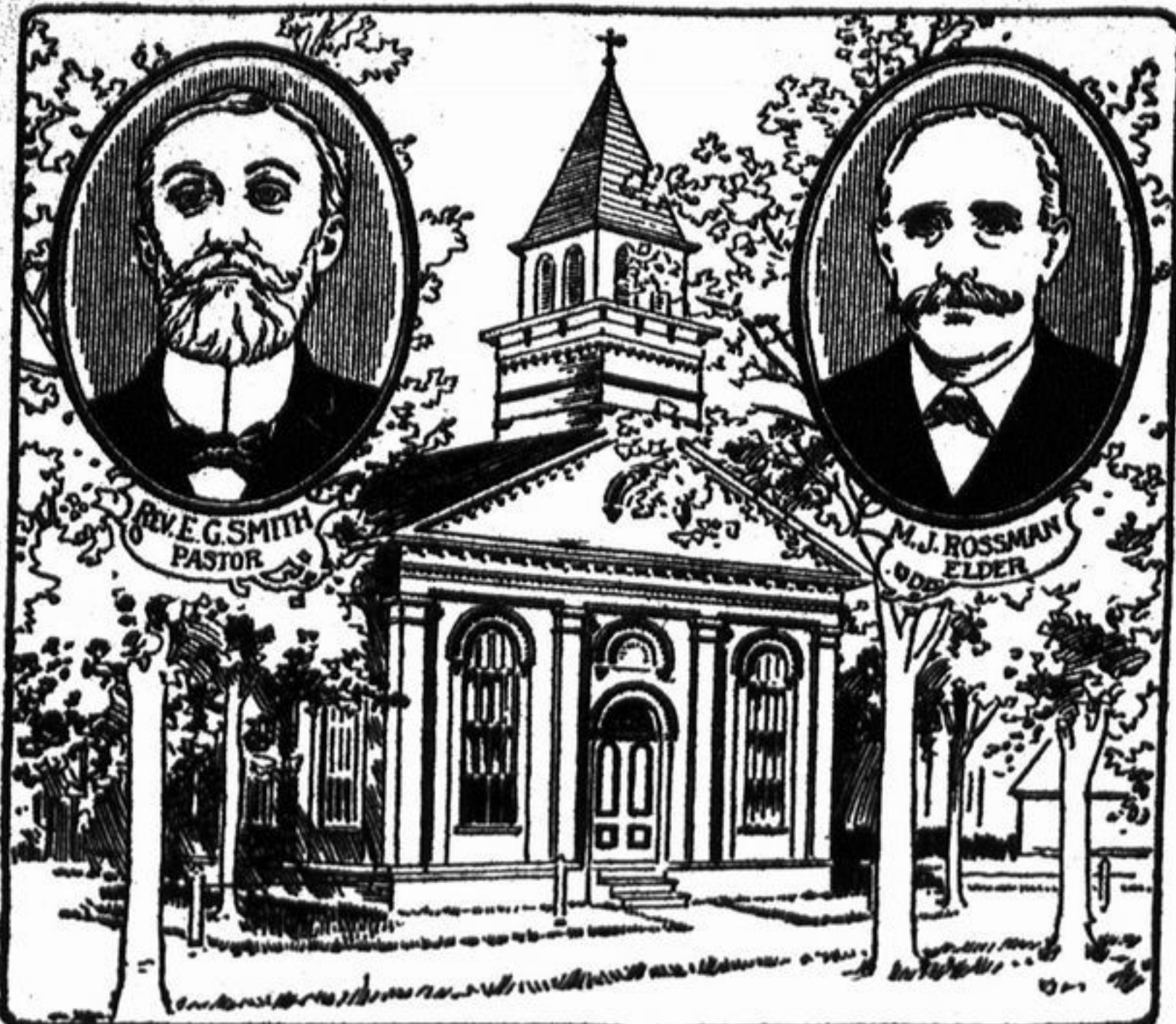

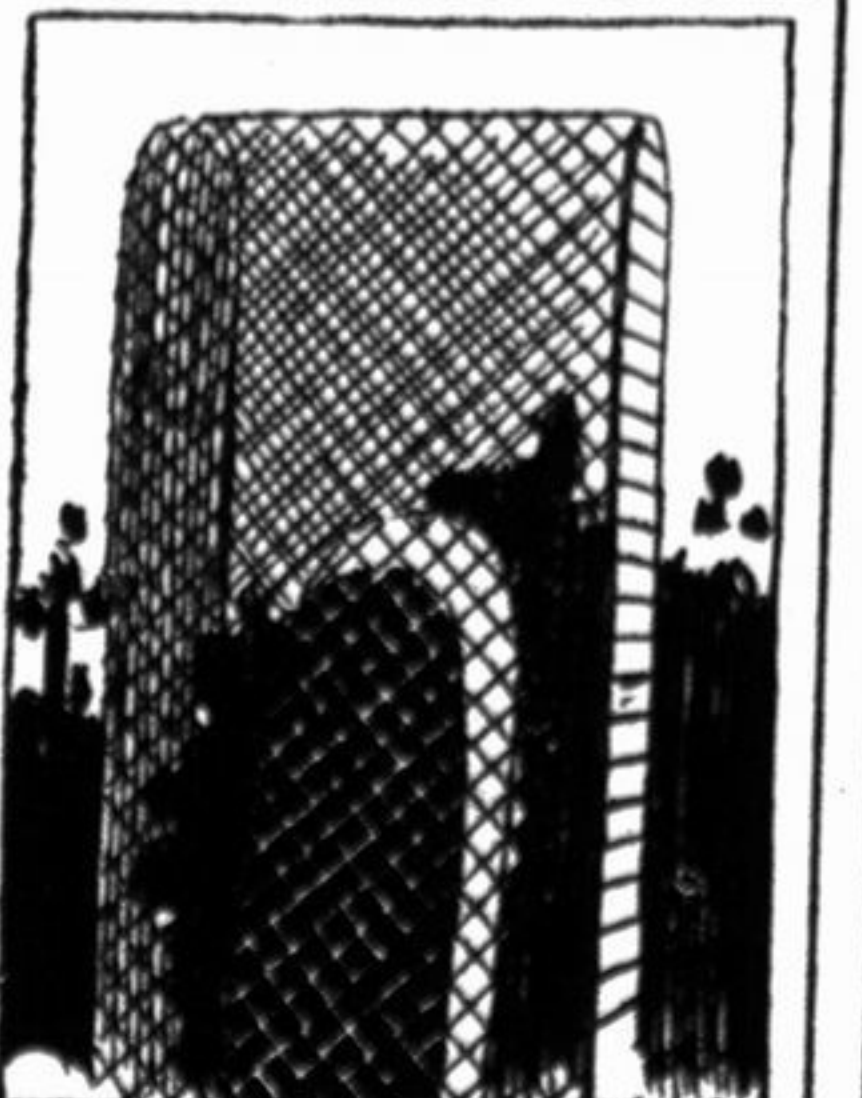


NELLIE GRANT SARTORIS. Nichols, a wealthy young resident of New York, popular among the younger social and exclusive set.

Mason and Dixon's Line.
Since the dispute over slavery and the war of the rebellion made Mason and Dixon's line famous, the stones which were set up along that survey in 1849 have been almost obliterated by relic hunters, thousands of whom have chipped off pieces to carry away with them. The wind and the weather also aided in the work of demolishing the stones, so that it was found necessary to replace them with new markers. These have just been finished by the state of Pennsylvania, and each of them has been surrounded by a heavy wire netting to protect it from the chisels of relic hunters.

Mason and Dixon's line was originally surveyed in 1760, after a dispute which had lasted nearly a century, and which was begun by William Penn and Lord Baltimore as to the boundary line between Maryland and Pennsylvania.

Mason and Dixon were two eminent English mathematicians who were brought over especially to settle the controversy. They ran the line and set up at the end of each mile a stone post, every fifth post being marked with the arms of Baltimore and Penn. In 1849 a second survey was made. The phrase "Mason and Dixon's line" first became



popular when in 1820 John Randolph referred to it in congress as the line which separated freedom from slavery.

Southern Progress.

The South has had a full share in the prosperity of the last few years, as can be demonstrated by a few statistics in agriculture and manufactures. In 1899 it raised 11,235,000 bales of cotton, as compared with 6,605,750 in 1880; 591,022,000 pounds of sugar, as compared with 198,962,278; 490,225,976 bushels of corn, as compared with 367,862,141, and 55,251,246 bushels of wheat, as compared with 51,625,126. During these 20 years the number of factories has increased from 180 to 663 and the amount of cotton consumed in these mills from 233,606 bales to 1,597,113. In the first six months of 1900 there were 194 cotton mills built in the United States, 175 of which are in the South. The production of iron has more than doubled in twelve years, while the output of coal has increased from 6,067,153 tons in 1880 to over 50,000,000 tons in 1900. With the increase in wealth which such statistics indicate there is every reason to believe that the South in this century will make corresponding advances on the lines of educational, religious, scientific and judicial progress, says Chicago Tribune.

Pettigrew's Son with Boers.

It is not generally known, perhaps, that Senator Pettigrew of South Dakota has a son who has been fighting with the Boers. He arrived in Savannah a few days ago and at once went to Washington. He is a lad of twenty years of age, who joined some 400 volunteers for service in the Transvaal. They were driven into the Portuguese territory and there disarmed, and the Dutch government paid their passage home. Young Pettigrew says that the Boers will make it interesting for the British for some time to come, and he
