Piero Insurance Companies, delug Bust-ness in the Village of December Crove, Illinois, for the boundt of the Local Fire Department:

Section 1. Bu it ordained by the Prosident and Board of Tracters of the Village of Downers Grove, Hillingis, that all corp-rations, companies and sencerations not incorporated under the laws of the State of Illinois, and which are engaged in offeeting fire insurance within the corporate limits of this Village, shall pay to the Village Treasurer the sum of two per cent of the gross receipts received by their respective agency or agencies fu this Vil-

Section 2. Said amount of two per concent shall be payable by such corporations, companies or associations upon the amount of all premiums, which during the year, ending on every first day of July 36 shall have been received for any insurance effected or agreed to be effected, within the corporate limits of this Village by or with such corporations, companies or associations.

Section 3. Every person who shall set in this Village as agent or otherwise for or in behalf of any such corporation, company or association, shall, on or before tie 15th day of July of each and every year, rouder to the Clerk of this Village a full, true and just account, verified by his ath, of all the premiums which during! the year enting on every first day of July preceding such report, shall have been received by him or any other person for him in behalf of any such corporation, company or amociation and shall specify in such report the amounts received for fire insurance.

Section 4. Such agents shall also pay to the Village Treasurer, at the time of endering the aforesaid report, the amount of rates for which the companies, corportions or associations represented by them are severally chargable by virtue of an Act of the legislature of the State of Illinois, ntitled, "An Act to Enable Cities, Townand Villager, Organized under any general or special law to levy and collect a tax or Leense fee from foreign Fire Insurance Companies for the benefit of an organized Fire department." In force July 1st, A. C. D., 1895, and by virtue of this ordinance passed in pursuance thereof. Provided, however, that all such companies, corporations or associations who may be doing bustness within the limits of this Village at the time this ordinance takes effect, -hall when rendering their first account in the manner berein provided, pay only on business transacted after the taking effect of this ordinance.

Section 5. If such an account be not rendered on or before the day herest designated for that purposes, or if the rates shall remain unpaid after that day it shall be unlawful for any corporation, company or association so in default to trameact any business of fire insurance within the corporate limits of this Village antil the requisitions of this ordinace have been fully complied with, provided, honever, that this provision shall not relieve and company, corporation or association from the payment of any rick that may be taken in violation bereaf.

Section 6. The Village Treasurer shall keep all the monies received by virtue or Richelleu Sundried Japan tea put up this ordinance, in a asperate fund to be He shall only disburse the monies belonging to this foud on proper Village wartrurk hauling, baggage and expressing rents duly signed by the President and attested by the Clerk of said Vill. go. > section 7. This ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage and legal publication. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

If such an indorsement as "photographs" or 'printed matter" is made, first-class rates must be paid, although this matter would ordinarily go at third-class rates. Instructions have been sent to postmasters to see that this rule is enforced,
