When Richard Yates carried Williamson county last year at an August ballot primary, at which every Republican in the county voted, the eight delegates of Williamson county were thereby instructed to vote on every ballot in the state convention for Yates. But day after day for three months the Chicago Tribune suppressed this vote by placing only four votes in the Yates column in its mailed statements and giving the rest to Rogers. The whole eight voted for Yates on every ballot and not one at any time voted for Rogers. Nobody knew then, and nobody knows now why it did it; but it did.

The Chicago press said Yates postponed Illinois Day at Buffalo, April 15th to 16th. This was not true. They said Gov. J. A. Brushingham, pastor First M. E. church, Chicago, attacked Yates in a sermon. This was a more serious untruth, according to Brushingham's own statement. They said he had appointed James Trabee his body guard, to ward off assassins. This was a silly lie. Trabee was, and is, a state house policeman, on duty at a point remote from the governor's office. Now comes a still more silly lie that the governor levies upon the parks and fish commission, for flowers and fish through a self-appointed "downer and fish bureau."

When Attorney General Hainke rendered his opinion as to the right of certain special attorneys, appointed by Governor Yates, to receive their pay from the state, but three special attorneys were involved. The attorney general held under the law the attorney for the insurance department was clearly entitled to a salary of \$4,000 and held that the salary of the attorney for the railroad and warehouse commission of \$1,500, and the salary of the attorney for the land commission of \$1,500, were not a legal charge upon the state; there being no appropriation for the same. It will be seen that but \$3,000, per year, in salaries were involved and that \$4,000 of this was a legitimate charge against the state, the saving to the state being but \$2,500 per year. And yet the Chicago press gloried over the statement that over \$200,000 to \$300,000 per year would be saved. This statement was intended to mislead and give out the impression that the state was thus saved from the extravagance of Governor Yates. As a matter of fact the state will not be saved a dollar in the matter of attorney fees, as they will now be paid through the attorney general.
