In almost all instances where business men invest in these things they do so because they fear that by refusing they will effend some church, society or other organization, and not because they care for either the entertainment or the Interest in which it is given. Every business man has his own charities, his church his lodge and his societies. To those h gives all be cares to spend in philanthropy -probably all he can well afford to spend -and all other contributions he regards as a species of polite blackmail.

If the good ladies who usually are foremost in the matter of ticket selling could know of the opinion in which they are held by the merchants on whom they call they could not be induced to engage in that practice. Possibly, too, if parents realised what nuisances their children become when they are engaged in a ticket salling contest, they would have none of the practice. Certainly a thorough appreciation of the evil would lessen it, and it is for the purpose of giving the public to understand how the business men feel regarding this subject that the rule of the merchants has been adopted.
