An ordinance for the establishing of a village datum or plane of reference for levels in the village of Downers Grove, DuPage county, Illinois. Be it ordained by the president and board of trustees of the village of Downers Grove:

That a base or datum for the levels of the village be established as follows, viz. Forty and seventy-three hundredths (40.73) feet below the top of the water table at the north-east corner of the C. B. & Q. railroad station on Main street, which is also fifty-three and fifty-nine one hundredths (53.59) feet below the top of the stone foundation at the north-west corner of the school building on the south-east corner of Washington street and Prairie avenue. The above plane of reference being one hundred (100) feet above the Chicago city datum.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. Passed and approved April 17th, 1905.
