OVER 100 DROWN

Two Passenger Steamers Collide at the Entrance to the Harbor.

CAPTAIN HEADS FOR SHORE

Orders Full Steam Ahead in Order to Ground the Craft, but She Goes Down Despite His Efforts-Rescuers Do Good Wark.

Marseilles, France, cablegram: The steamers Insulaire and Liban collided off this port. The Liban sank, and more than 100 of the passengers and crew drowned.

Both vessels were passenger steamers. The Liban, with 240 passengers, sailed on its regular trip for Bastia, Corsica. The Insulaire was coming into port. Marie island, at the entrance of the harbor, hid the steamers from each other until it was too late to avoid the collision.

The Insulaire crashed into the Liban's side at full speed, cutting a great hole, through which the water poured with a rush.

The captain of the Liban turned the steamer and ordering full speed ahead began a race for shore, hoping to ground his vessel. For seventeen minutes the steamer kept the course and then the fore part of the vessel plunged under the water and almost in an instant the ship had disappeared.

The collision was witnessed from the pilot boat Blechamp, which was about two miles distant. The Blechamp immediately repaired to the spot to render assistance. The steamer Balkan and other vessels also drew near the sinking ship and made desperate efforts to rescue those on board The Blechamp picked up forty persons. many of whom were at the point of exhaustion. The Balkan rescued thirty-seven passengers. In addition to the passengers seventeen of the crew were also saved

Officers of the steamer Balkan describe the scene just before the Liban disappeared as a terrible one. As the vessel was sinking it was inclined to such an angle that the masts struck the water, causing an eddy which made the work of rescue most difficult. A mass of human beings were clinging to the foundering vessel and uttered despairing cries as it went down.

Boilers Explode.

As the vessel sank the bollers exploded, intensifying the horrors. For a few moments the victims were seen struggling in the sea, then the waves closed over them and all was silent.

The Balken launched three boats and the other vessels did all possible to save the victims in the short time that elapsed between the time of the collision and the sinking of the Liban. One of the survivors gives the following details of the disaster:

"The weather was splendid when we steamed out of Marseilles harbor and all the passengers were below at table when the shricking of whistles gave the alarm. On coming on deck I saw the Insulaire approaching us at full speed. The captain gave several orders, but no attempt apparently was made to change the steamer's course. Some of the passengers reproached the captain for his negligence in this

"When the Insulaire crashed into us a great panic prevailed on board. Attempts were made to lower the boats, but only one boat was got away. and in that I and a few others escaped to the Belchamp. As the vessel sank bow first the passengers took refuge on the after deck, which was covered by an awning. This, as the Liban foundered, became a cage in which the passengers were caught and dragged down beneath the waters."

Many of the rescued were injured in the collision. The Insulaire sustained considerable damage to its hows, but managed to reach port
