C. Bliss Man of Many Aliases Arrested at Monmouth.

Kane County Will Have Second Hanging in Its History-Peddler Robbed at East Grove Other County News From Exchanges.

The Pinkerton detectives, who were here and at Hinsdale last week on the trail of J. C. Bliss, wanted for forgery, arrested their man at Monmouth, Wednesday upon his return from Alexis, Ills., where he had been lecturing and preparing to work his smooth game. Bliss is an expert forger and an ex-convict. Three weeks ago Rev. J. C. Bliss, alias J. S. C. Bliss, alias J. C. S. Bliss, alias Rev. A. A. 


