SIDEWALK ORDINANCE NO. 83.

An Ordinance for a sidewalk in the village of Downers Grove, DuPage county and state of Illinois.

Be it ordained by the president and board of trustees of the village of Downers Grove, DuPage county, Illinois:

Section 1. That a sidewalk be constructed in said village on the south owners thereof, and the frontage of every detail. There is no country unside of Curtiss street immediately in front of the following described lots or parcels of land: Part lot 84, Assessub-division, from Martha Barber's west line to Carpenter street, and that the whole cost thereof be paid by a special tax to be levied upon such lots or parcels of land, in proportion to their frontage upon such sidewalk, in scoordance with the statute in such case made and provided.


