SIDEWALK ORDINANCE NO. 88.

N ORDINANCE for a sidewalk in the village of Downers Grove, DuPage county and state of Illinois.

Be it ordained by the president and board of trustees of the village of Downers Grove, DuPage county, Illinois: Section 1. That a sidewalk be con-

structed in said village on the south side of Curtiss street immediately in front of the following described lots or parcels of land: Part of lot 49 Assessorssub-division, being land owned by Mary Kellor and heirs of Blackburn and that the whole cost thereof be paid by a special tax to be levied upon such lots or parcels of land, in proportion to their frontage upon such sidewalk, in accordance with the statute in such case made and provided.

Sec. 2. Said side walk shall be 4 feet 8 inches wide and constructed of c ment. Said cement sidewalk shall constructed of material and in the manner hereinafter provided. Foundations for said cement sidewalk shall be prepared by bringing the space to be occupied by the sidewalk to a grade 12 inches below the established grade give en herein. When necessary, the subfoundation must be consolidated by wetting and ramming to give the proper solidity. Soft and spongy ground or grass or vegetable matter or sod must be dug out and the place refilled with solid material. Upon the subgrade, 12 inches below the established grade, shall be placed a foundation of cinders. Said foundation shall not be less than 7 inches thick and 4 feet 8 inches wide after being flooded and thorthat purpose. Upon said foundation ed of cinders as aforesaid, the surface of which foundation of cinders shall be 5 inches below the finished grade or the grade as herein stipulated, there shall be laid a layer of cement concrete 4 inches thick and 4 feet 8 inches wide throughout the entire length of said sidewalk upon the lines as above speci- 1908. of one part of Alpha Portland comen or other Portland coment equally as 35 good, three parts of torpedo grayel and five parts of broken limestone, by volume which shall be carefully measured; said material shall then be thoroughly mixed dry by being turned with shevels | ele twice while in a dry state. After the addition of the necessary amount of water, which shall be sprayed upon said material, the mixture shall be again turned twice with shovels before being spread upon the foundation. After being spread it shall be rammed until free mortar appears on the surface. On this concrete before it shall have time to set, shall be placed a wearing sur face one inch thick, composed of one part Alpha Portland cement, or other Portland cement equally as good, and one part clean Torpedo sand, This top For personal loans call on W. All of said sidewalk shall be laid in sections 5 feet wide each for the full width of the walk, each section to be entirely separate from the adjoining sections, to the whole depth of the concrete. The joints shall be smooth, straight and plumb throughout their depth and at right angles to the line

CEMENT. -All cement shall be Alpha Portland cement, or other Portland cement equally as good, and shall be subject to the inspection and approval of the president and street and alley committee of the board of trustees.

SAND.—All sand and gravel used in concrete and in the top surface of the walk shall be a clean Torpedo sand, free from gray, foreign or earthy matter of

STONE. -All broken stone shall be of a hard limestone, broken to a uniform Subscriptions for the REPORTER may size so as to pass through a ring onebe left with D. G. Graham who will half inch in diameter, and shall be also accept and receipt for arrears and clean and free from all particles of foreign material.

Side Filling.—On each side of the walk, after it shall have been built and the cement properly hardened, clean earth shall be banked up against the walk, level with the top thereof, extending two feet beyond its sides and sloping downward in the ratio of onehalf horizontal to one vertical, until the natural surface of the ground is reached; this filling to be carefully smoothed off with rakes to a smooth surface. > Said sidewalk shall be built under the supervision of the president and street and alley committee of the board of trustees and built in accordance with the grade fixed by the street commis-

Sec. 3. All owners of lots or parcels of land aforesaid, are hereby required to construct the sidewalk in front of their respective land aforesaid within forty days after the publishing of this ordinance, in full accordance with the specifications aforesaid, and in default thereof said cement, sand and all other materials and labor shall be furnished and the said sidewalk constructed by

Sec. 4. The street and alley committee of the board of trustees of the said village of Downers Grove shall certify to the bill of the costs of such sidewalk when constructed by said village, a aforesaid, showing in separate items the costs of grading, materials, construction and supervision and file it in the office of the village clerk of said village, together with a list of the lots or parcels of land touching upon the line of said sidewalk and the name of the owners thereof, and the frontage of their said lots or parcels of land on said sidewalk so constructed.

Sec. 5. The viltage collector is hereby designated as the officer to collect the special tax herein provided for and and to whom the bills or warrants for the same shall be given for collection, in accordance with the statute in such case made and provided.

Sec. 6 The village clerk shall comply with the previsions of "An Act to provide additional means for the construction of sidewalks in cities, towns and villages, approved April 15th, 1875, and in force July 1st, 1875," in accordance with which said statute this ordinance is passed; and if any land is delinquent after the return of the warrant of collection of said special tax by the said village collector to the said clerk, then said clerk shall make a re port of all such special tax in writing to the county treasurer and ex-officie county collector of DuPage county, state of Illinois, prior to April 1st, 1904, as required by said act; said county treasurer and ex-officio county collector shall then have full authority to collect the same as previded by said act.

Sec. 7. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with or contrary to any of the provisions of this ordinance, oughly rammed with tools made for are each and all of them hereby repeal-

> Sec. 8. This ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the manner as required by law.


