Aurora Girl Shoots Lover

Thrashing Engine Blown up and Many Injured at Batavia.

Petit Jurors Chosen for the October Term of Circuit Court—Hinsdale Man a Suicide—Other County News from Exchanges.

Because her lover, Ernest Berry, refused to marry her, Della Walton shot at him with a revolver, and thinking she had killed him, sent a bullet through her own brain, from the effects of which she died late Thursday afternoon at the city hospital, Aurora. The affair is the result of a quarrel. Shortly after noon the two walked down the street together and the girl asked Berry to marry her, but he refused and they parted. About 1 o'clock she saw him returning to work and hurried to meet him. She handed him a letter and as he took it pulled a revolver from the folds of her dress and shot at him, then turned the weapon on herself. The bullet passed through the rim of his hat and out at the crown. Berry refused to discuss the matter at the station where he was taken after the shooting.

Without a moment's warning and when everything appeared to be in perfect working order, the thrashing machine belonging to Ed. and Frank Kautz and working on the Otto Gard farm, blew on Wednesday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock and one man was instantly killed and a number of others were injured says the Geneva Republican. John Stephens of Aurora was instantly killed. The injured are Frank Updike of Geneva, right leg broken in two places and three ribs broken. John and Fred Kautz, Otto Gard and Ralph Corryell were struck by pieces of iron. No one is in a position to say what caused the accident.

Wm. Menold, a carpenter living in the western part of Hinsdale, committed suicide Thursday evening by taking carbolic acid. He had been drinking considerably and a family disagreement is said to have caused a spell of melancholia. Menold was a man of 45 years and came here from Naperville 12 years ago. Until a week ago he was employed as a carpenter by Henry Buchholz. Coroner Matter held an inquest Friday morning, rendering a verdict of death by taking carbolic acid with suicidal intent.

Wm. Slets, a pauper from Lisle township, died of old age at the almshouse on Sunday morning. His age was 85 years. The remains were taken to Naperville for interment.

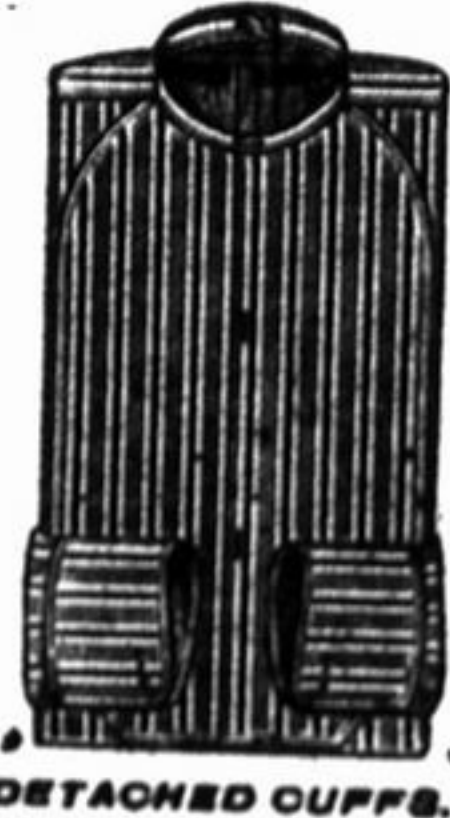
