The committee of the Illinois commit elouers having this matter in charge sists of Walter Warder of Caire, J. N. Shumway of Taylorville and H. M. Dunlap of Savey. These gentlemen have been anxious about this exhibit, because of the important relation it bears to the wealth of the state and the difficulties of assemb ling suitable and representations of everything covered in the title. For more than a month they have been considering plans for what they want and have given the superintendence of the job into the hands of Chas. T. Wilder, a graduate of the university of Illinois, and a very competent man, who is at work on the task before

To begin with the exhibit will have a geological map of the state, and separate ceal maps showing the location of all the mines, washing plants and coal railroads in the state. Maps will show also the distribution of the clay industries,

Diagrams figuring stratographical sections of the state will be furnished and it is hoped to show many of the interesting geological features by means of photography. In addition to these a series of maps and charts is proposed to show the development and present condition of the min-

It is understood that the association of coal operators will have a leading part in the exhibit of their product; but an effort will be made to show coal and coke on the largest scale ever attempted for Illinois, The finest lot of chinaware for the and to make the exhibit of scientific val-

ue. In this connection the university of Illinois will be drawn upon for a series of analysis of 100 typical coals of the state, showing their value and certain physical and chemical features.

Exhibits of the industries connected with the clays and earths of the state, showing the products and materials, such as terra cotta and pressed brick, stoneware and pottery, tile and tiling, building brick and drain tile, fire brick and ganister; are already in process of preparation, Fresh beef by the quarter during each to display chemical analysis and the customary physical tests, with suitable information as to processes of manufacture and location of material and places of production.
