BURLINGTON TO OPEN ST. LOUIS LINE.

The Chicago, Burlington & Quincy management has decided to operate a through passenger service between Chicago and St. Louis for the exposttion next summer. The route will be from Chicago to Galesburg on the present Chicago-Denver main line, and from Galesburg to St. Louis over the present road by way of Bushnell and Beardstown. Though the Burlington has always had a line of track between Chicago and St. Louis no passenger service has ever been operated between these points by reason of its long mileage, the distance between the two cities being something over 850 miles. as against a little less than 300 miles by the shortest line. Next summer, however, the officers of the Burlington figure that the travel will be so heavy between Chicago and St. Louis that a few miles will make little difference when accomodations are considered. It is believed that the bulk of the business between the two cities will desire to make the trip in both directions at night, and the Burlington will be in a position to cover the distance during the night as well as its competitors.
