RULES FOR LENTEN SEASON.

Archbishop Quigley has issued a formal letter to the Roman Catholic clergy of the archdiocese of Chicago, in which he sets forth the regulations for the Lenten season which began yesterday. "All the days of Lent from Ash Wednesday, which this year falls on the 17 of February, to Easter Sunday, Sundays excepted, are fast days of obligation on all persons who have attained the age of 21 years and are not otherwise, for sufficient reasons, exempted or lawfully dispensed from same.

Those obliged to fast are restricted to one full meal in the day, which shall not ordinarily be taken before noon and a collation not to exceed the fourth part of an ordinary meal in the evening, though the use of some warm drink, such as tea, coffee or chocolate in the morning is authorized.

Abstinence from flesh meat implied in the precept of fasting is, in this diocese, dispensed with on Sundays, without restriction, and at the principal meal on all other days, except Wednesdays and Fridays, and the Saturdays in Ember week and Holy week.

The sick, and in general all who, on account of old age or weakly constitutions, cannot fast without detriment to their health, are exempted from fasting.

Those who are not bound to fast are not restricted in the use of meat on days when its use is allowed by dispensations at the principal meal.

Fish and flesh meats are not allowed at the same meal.

Lard may be used instead of butter in preparing a fast day diet.

Above dispensations from the general laws are granted in virtue of an indulgence given by the apostolic see, for ten years, March 15, 1895.

You will please to make known and explain to your people the following dispensation from the law of abstinence in favor of workmen, which is granted by virtue of an indulgence of the holy see, bearing date, March 15, 1895:

Workingmen and their families are permitted to use flesh meat once a day on all fast days and abstinence days throughout the year, with the exception of Fridays, Ash Wednesday, the Wednesday and Saturday of holy week and the vigil of Christmas.

Those who avail themselves of this indulgence are not allowed to use meat and fish at the same meal, and it is the earnest desire of the holy see that they perform some other act of mortification, such as abstinence from intoxicating liquors.

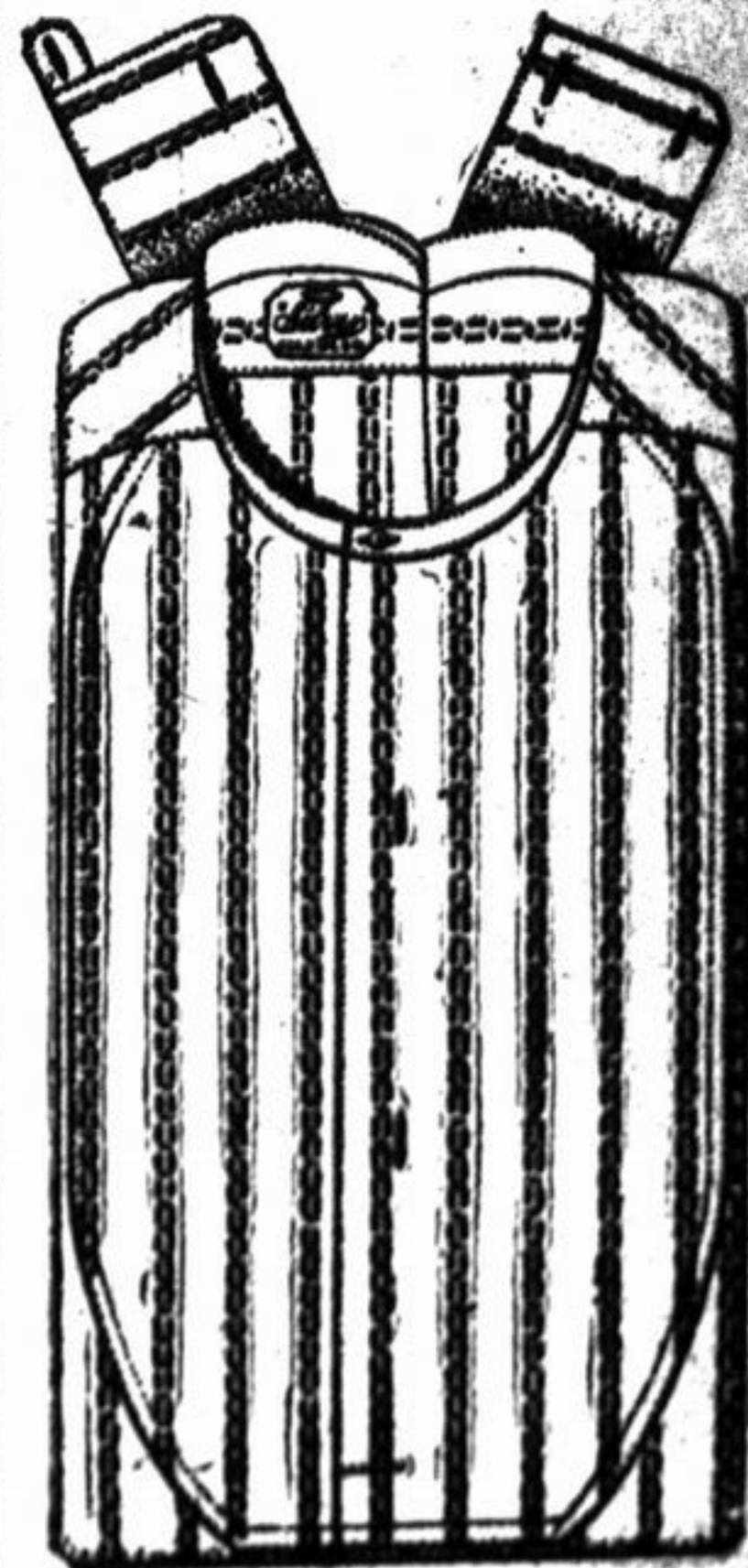
