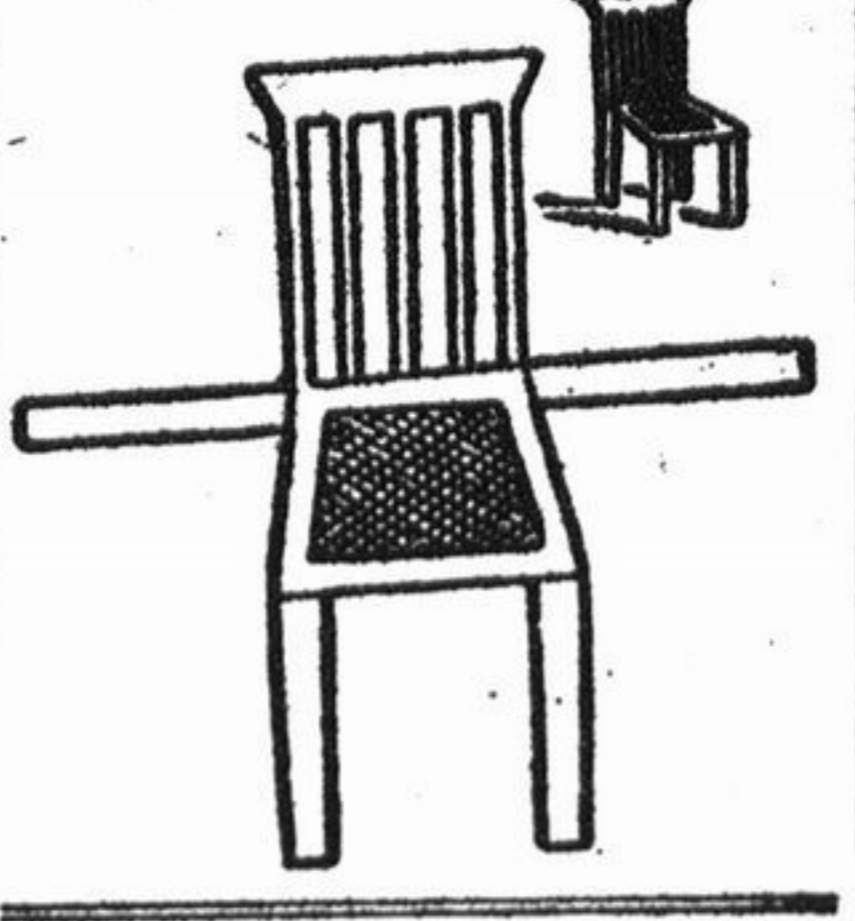

CHAIR FOR DOLL'S HOUSE

Notice of Cardboard Furniture Ag-
 A great deal of fun and amusement can be derived in making cardboard furniture, and with the exercise of a little ingenuity, chairs, tables, stools, and all kinds of furniture can be constructed. As an example, to illustrate this, we give a diagram of a chair, which can be traced and then pasted on to a thin piece of cardboard and left to dry, and then carefully cut out with a sharp pair of scissors. After that it is an easy matter to bend the legs and back into their proper positions, and when this has been done the chair will have the appearance shown in the small sketch.



on the right-hand side, and to complete it, the paint-box may be called into requisition, and it can be colored.

The dotted lines in the diagram indicate the points at which the cardboard should be bent, and it is a good plan to score across the cardboard at these places with the point of a pen-knife, in order that it may bend freely.
