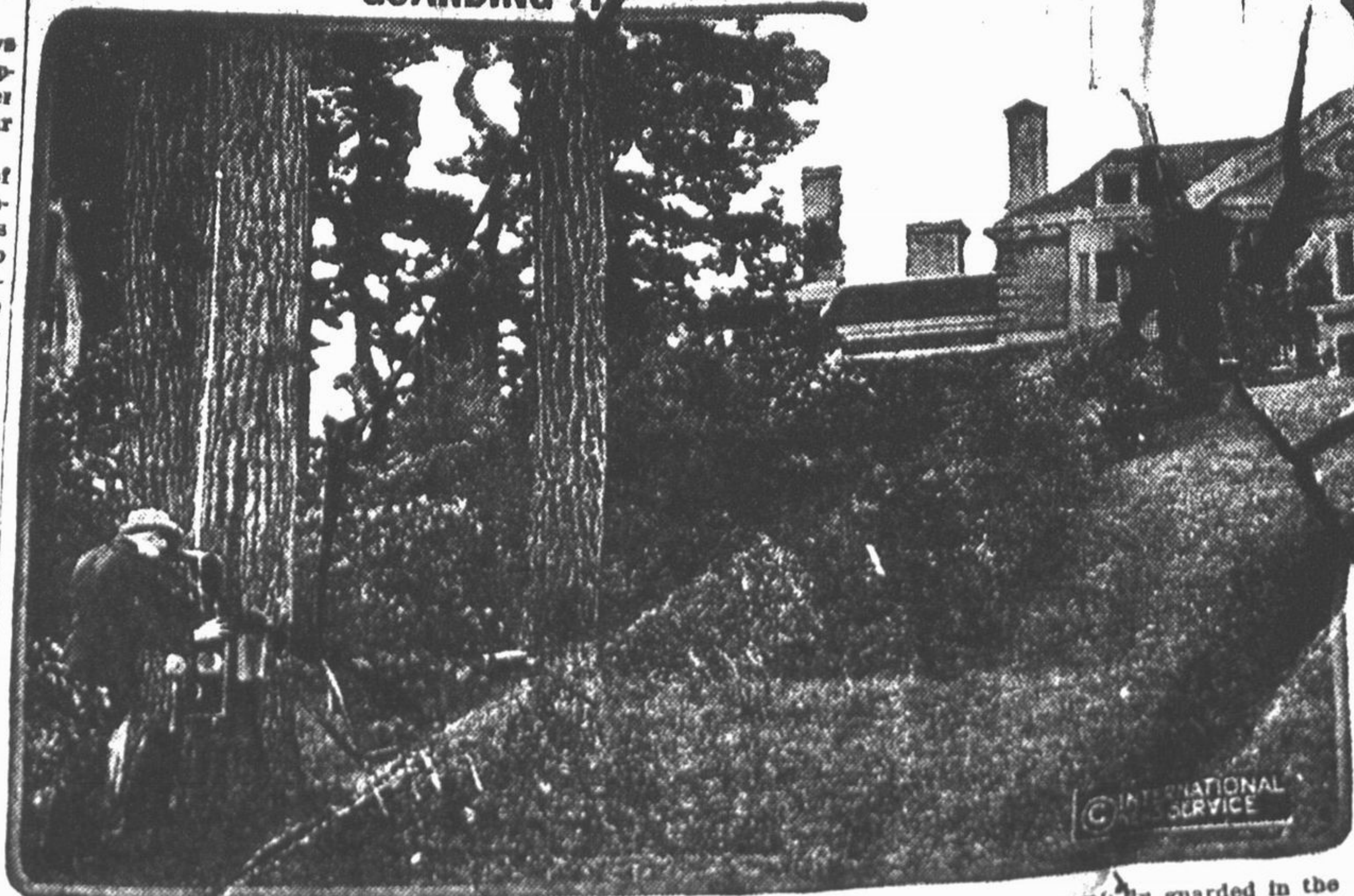
...humanity which are the founda-

international law, all distinctions be-

have been obliterated by the order to  
British merchantmen to arm them-  
selves and to ram submarines, and the  
promise of rewards therefor, and neu-  
trals who use merchantmen as travel-  
ers thereby have been exposed in an  
increasing degree to all the dangers  
of war.  
...If the commander of the German  
submarine which destroyed the Lusitania  
had caused the crew and passen-  
gers to take to the boats before firing  
a torpedo this would have meant the  
sure destruction of his own vessel.  
...After the experiences in sinking  
less seaworthy ves-  
sels it may be expected that a  
submarine would  
not long enough even  
to permit passen-  
gers to take to the  
ship's boats  
of a very peculiar  
presence on board  
of highly explosive  
substances, possibly  
disruption.  
...It may be pointed out  
that the Lusitania  
had been spared  
of munitions would  
be used against  
Germany's enemies,  
hundreds of German  
soldiers would  
be killed of bread.
