To the Editor of the Downers Grove Post:

Concerning the west my attention was called to an article contained in the issue of your paper of May 20th, 1918, and signed Anson ...

The article is full of misapprehension of the law as well as of the facts, and in order to point out these misapprehensions more space would be required than you are willing to allot me.

For that reason I will content myself with saying that the issues involved are now in process of litigation in the Circuit Court of Du Page County and will not doubt come to a trial at an early date, and further discussion in your paper would avail nothing whatsoever.

My object has been accomplished, viz.: to lay before the people of the village the real condition of our special assessments. I have before me certified copies of the stipulations of fact filed by the attorneys for the village of Downers Grove, in the suits pending against the village, which documents are very voluminous, and there is no doubt in my mind, judging from the amount of work done so far in these cases, whether necessary or not, will incur a heavy bill of expense as the village for attorney's fees, and I believe that I am correct in assuming that these attorney fees will be far in excess of the expenses that would have been involved had the proper steps been taken and the necessary supplemental assessments levied.

Mr. Shaw in his former communication stated that the expense involved in levying a supplemental assessment is the same as in the original assessment. In this he is entirely mistaken, as the proceedings before the Board of Local Improvements, in accordance to original special assessments, are not necessary in supplemental special assessment proceedings, and any one acquainted with such matters knows that the largest amount of work is done well before the ordinance for the improvement is ready for passage.

A CITIZENS' PEACE CRUSADE—A NEW NATIONAL MOVEMENT.

Apparently potent with splendid possibilities—and even now larger than the proverbial flock on the horizon—a real live fresh effort toward ending the awful slaughter abroad is formulating and is about to commence in Du Page County. It is a movement springing directly from the body of the people at large, is tied up to no organization of any sort whatsoever, and is thoroughly impartial in tone and sympathy.

A call has been issued to one hundred live-spirited citizens of the county to meet at dinner at the Kimball Cafe in the New York Life Building, Chicago, Tuesday evening next, the 24th, at 5:30 o'clock, where the plan for the county canvass will be launched.

Approved as it has been by some of those highest in public position and esteem in the land, the issue has also been thoroughly tested out in the village of Hinsdale in this county, where over one thousand citizens' signatures—or above ninety per cent—have been obtained.

This movement is based upon the following:

(1) That the real influence of a country is that of its people at large, and that the warring nations abroad are not likely to listen to any more diplomatic appeals for peace, at least not before the point of exhaustion has been reached in the fearful conflict.

(2) That there is a duty, as well as a privilege, resting upon the neutral peoples, with all their fully aroused and concentrated influence to furnish or tender these deluded nations some definite and feasible plan for an armistice, otherwise the awful slaughter is apt to continue indefinitely.

(3) The "entering wedge" of this memorial is an appeal to each and all of the nations involved, and on the basis of a simple duty to at least appoint agents of peace who will immediately commence their labors and continue to strive to that end, even though the fighting is going on.

That such agents, should, acting together, call for an armistice and have the same accomplished, to allow terms of peace to be attempted a thing which the rulers of the warring peoples cannot separately, that is, will not do. There is scarcely any one but who believes that if an armistice or truce be accomplished the terrible slaughter will never commence again.

The memorial contains the following significant announcement:

"The within memorial is to be submitted strictly in supplement to the efforts of our President in behalf of peace and in the spirit of aid thereto, and the manner of its use in the present dread emergency is to be left to his judgment and discretion."
