SEASON'S experiences with a locating crew on the first government railroad in the interior of Alaska would fill a book. ELIJAH AND THE PROPHETS OF BAAL. LESSON TEXT—1 Kings 18:20-38. GOLDEN TEXT—Jehovah is far from the wicked; but he heareth the prayer of the righteous. Prov. 15:29 R. V.

Following the lesson of last week we have (ch. 18:1-16) the interesting account of Ahab's search for Elijah and the prophet's meeting with Obadiah. Verses 5 and 6 suggest the severity of the drought in the land.
