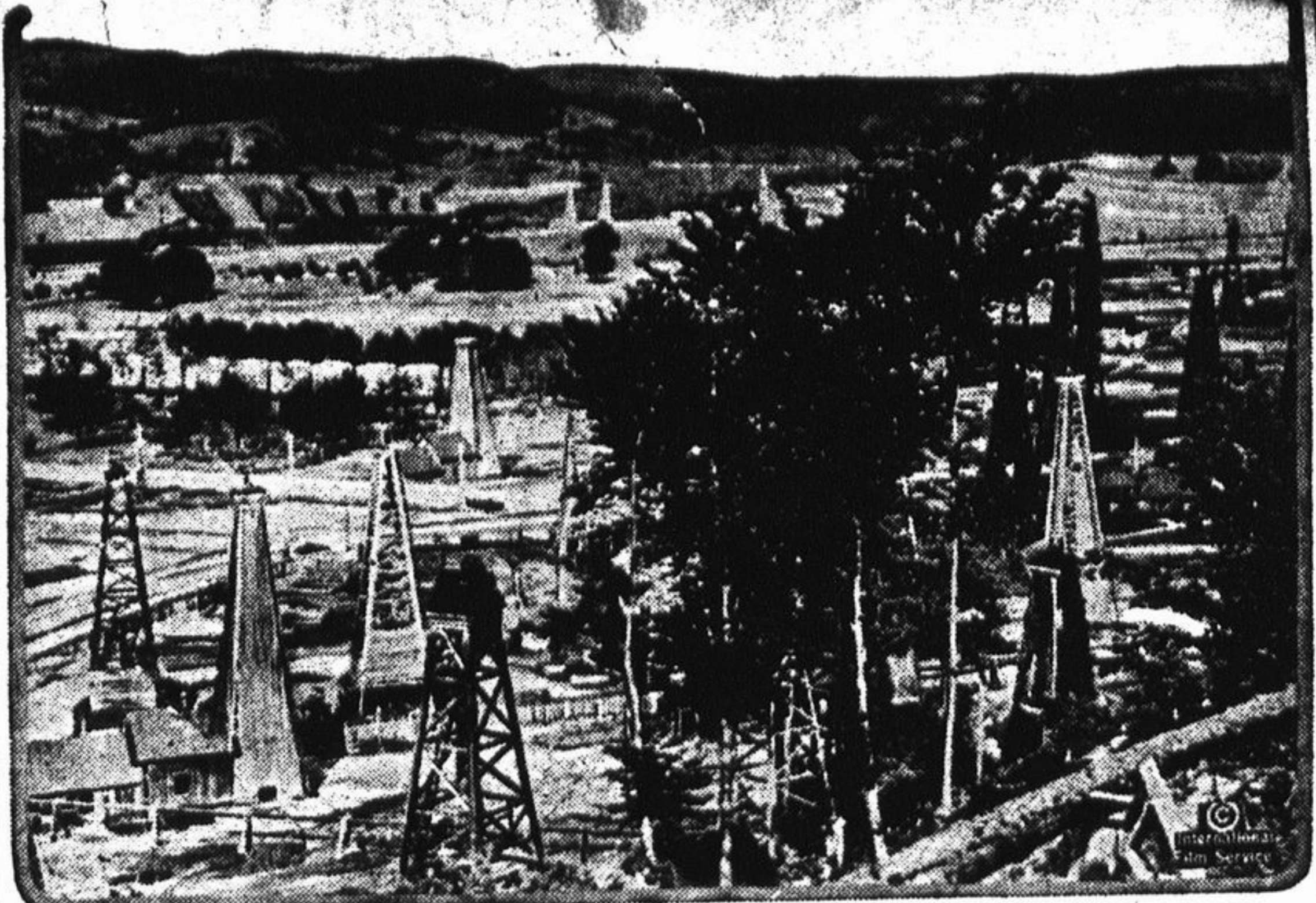


OIL FIELDS WRECKED BY FLEEING ROUMANIANS

"One must occasionally go to Europe to appreciate America. Here you all have opportunity. You can have your little home and can work if you will.

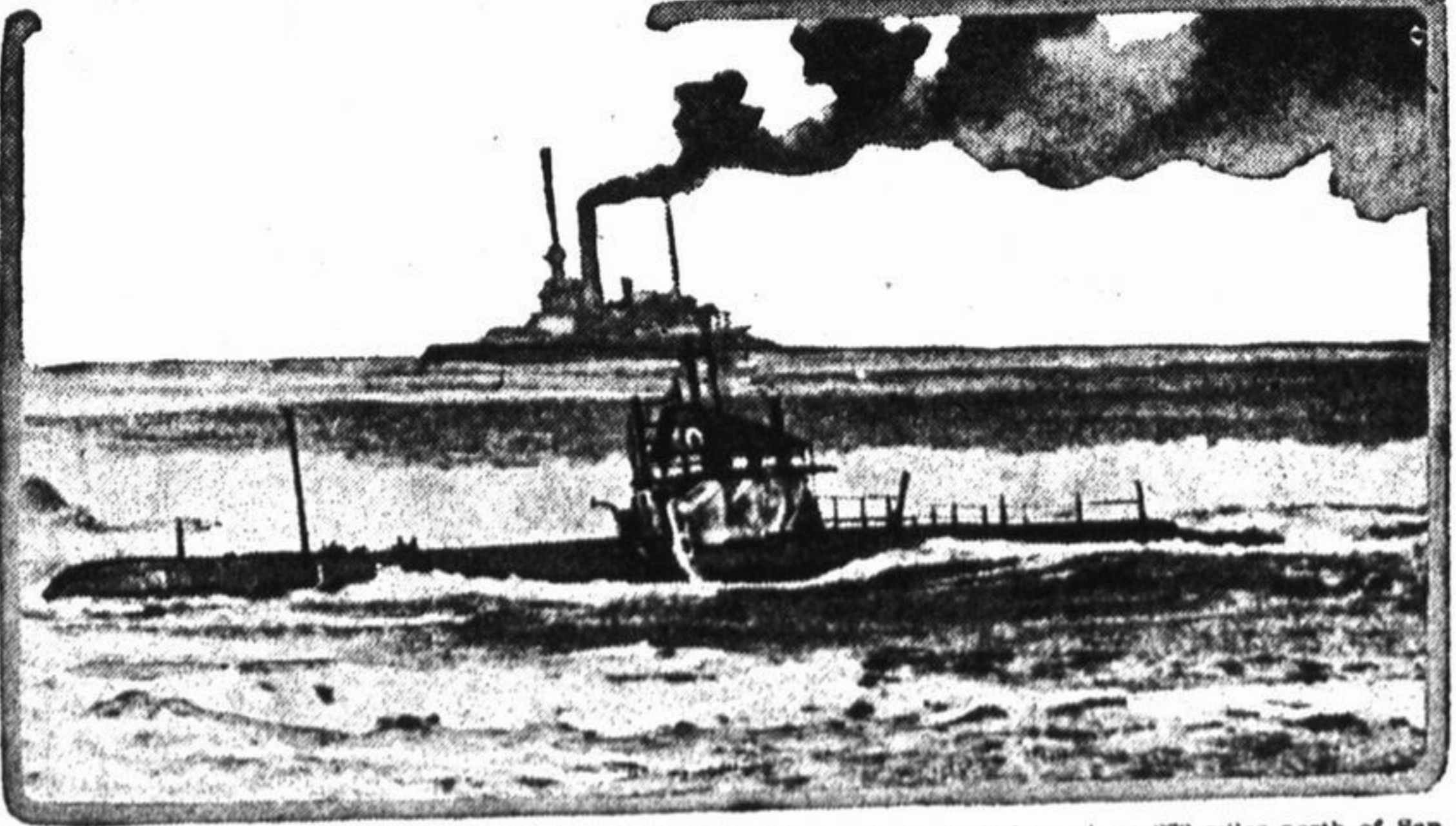
Kept at Home. "Is your outlook on life changed, now that you are a married man?" "I suspect so," replied the benedict who was formerly a gay bachelor.
